

Color Exploration: Learn how to select colors and fabrics for your quilts that make them sing and give them that extra zing! We will play with fabric and have fun completing several hands-on activities to see how colors interact to create mood, depth, balance and movement. We will make friends with the color wheel and use this easy and versatile tool to select successful eye-catching color combinations for quilt blocks, borders and thread. You will leave class with a better understanding of how colors interact and plenty of color scheme ideas for future quilts. Appropriate for all levels.



Supply List:

- Color Wheel – highly recommend Joen Wolfrom’s Ultimate 3-in-1 Color Tool, but any color wheel will work, including Joen’s Essential Color Wheel.
- Notebook to take notes
- Optional - a few fabrics in your favorite colors or combinations for inspiration (you won’t need to cut them up!)
- Optional – quilt tops or UFOs that have you stumped – what color border or thread would look good? What can I add to liven this quilt up?
- Optional – fabric/scrap in assorted colors and values in mostly tone on tones (single color vs multiple different colors). Include lights, mediums, darks, neutrals, bright, dull, etc. *The instructor will bring a bag of scraps, but the more the merrier when we start to play! If you’re like most quilters, you already have a bag (or bags!!!) of scraps - only bring if you already have scraps. Don’t cut up fabric for this class!*
