Helpful tools ~ BlocLoc rulers for trimming up ~ 4-1/2" HST square up, & 1-1/2" x 3" Flying Geese ruler Creative Grids Quick Trim Ruler & 3" Wave Ruler

For Center Appliqué block cut:

(1) Background rectangle 10" x 13". Trace the templates for the appliqué pieces (add seam allowance to each piece if doing needle turn appliqué). Tip: Use the Creative Grids 3" Wave Ruler to layer several "ground" pieces across the bottom. After appliqué is finished, trim the center block to 9-1/2" x 12-1/2".

For Pieced Bloom Block 1 cut:

- (4) Light Yellow 3" squares, and (4) background 3" squares. With them, make (8) Half Square Triangle blocks and trim/square them to 2-1/2".
- (8) Golden Yellow 2-1/2" squares
- (2) Green 2-1/2" squares

Arrange them in a nine patch block configuration and sew together in rows. Block should measure 6-1/2".

For Pieced Bloom Block 2 cut:

- (8) Purple 3" squares, and (8) background 3" squares. With them, make 16 Half Square Triangle blocks and trim/square them to 2-1/2".
- (2) Blue 2-1/2" squares.

Arrange them in a nine patch block configuration and sew together in rows. Block should measure 6-1/2".

For Flying Geese Spacer Blocks:

Using your favorite method for making Flying Geese Blocks, make (16) Flying Geese Blocks and trim them to 2" x 3-1/2" (finished size will be 1-1/2" x 3").

Use (4) Flying Geese units to make each Spacer Block by arranging them in a row, two pointing toward the left, and two pointing toward the right. Make (4) Spacer blocks that measure 3-1/2" x 6-1/2".

Sew a Spacer Block to the bottom of each of the Pieced Bloom Blocks. Arrange the units in a row, and piece them together. Row should measure 9-1/2" x 36-1/2"





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
