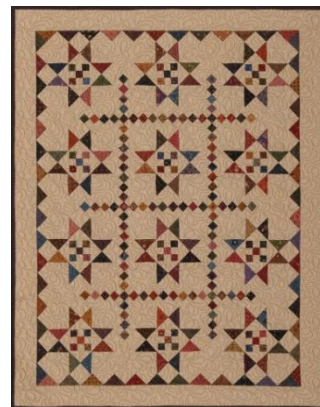




Starry, Starry Nines ~ Class Supply List

Welcome to the *Starry, Starry Nines* workshop!! This wonderful and versatile quilt can be made in two different sizes!! Just choose what size block/quilt you'd like to make, and reference the yardage requirements for your chosen quilt. Then, follow the fabric preparation directions and cutting instructions for your chosen size. I'm really looking forward to meeting you soon!!



★Preparations:

* I highly recommend preparing your fabrics with spray sizing!! This step is optional, but will be an enormous help with every step of piecing. Thoroughly and evenly spray your fabric yardage before cutting!! Press it dry with a dry iron. I use Magic Spray sizing in the blue can available at Walmart, Target, and grocery stores. You may need several cans.

* After sizing your fabrics cut your entire quilt following the cutting directions for the quilt size you've chosen.




★Fabrics & Cutting Instructions for 4½" block ~ Quilt size 23" x 29":

- ♥ 1 yard of light print for blocks, background and borders.
- ♥ (27) assorted 5" dark print squares and/or scraps for blocks.
- ♥ ¼ yard for binding.
- ♥ ⅞ yard for backing.

✂ Cutting Instructions ✂

✂ From the light print ~ for blocks, background, and borders:

*Cut (2) 2½" x WOF strips ~ subcut (24) 2½" x 2½" squares ~ crosscut  once for Nine Patch Square in a Square units, in the Nine Patch Sawtooth Star blocks.

*Cut (3) 2" x WOF strips for borders.

*Cut (4) 2½" x WOF strips ~subcut (48) 2½" x 2½" squares for Half Square Triangles (HST) in Nine Patch Sawtooth Star blocks.

~ subcut (24) 2" x 2" squares for Double Nine Patch blocks.

*Cut (5) 1⅝" x WOF strips ~ subcut (10) 1⅝" x 3⅞" rectangles for side setting triangle blocks.

~ subcut (10) 1⅝" x 2¾" rectangles for side setting triangle blocks.

~ subcut (4) 1⅝" x 2¾" rectangles for corner setting triangle blocks.

~ subcut (48) 1⅝" x 1⅝" squares for Nine Patch Sawtooth Star blocks.


~ subcut (10) 1⅝" x 1⅝" squares for side setting triangle blocks.

*Cut (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips ~ subcut (48) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1" rectangles for Double Nine Patch blocks.

*Cut (3) 1" x WOF strips ~ subcut (72) 1" x 1" squares for Double Nine Patch blocks.
~ subcut (48) 1" x 1" squares for Nine Patch Sawtooth Stars blocks.

✂ From (27) assorted 5" dark print squares and/or assorted scraps:

*Cut (48) assorted $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for HST in Nine Patch Sawtooth Stars blocks.

*Cut (28) assorted 2" x 2" squares ~ crosscut once  diagonally for corner and side setting triangle blocks.

*Cut (102) assorted 1" x 1" squares for Double Nine Patch blocks.

*Cut (60) assorted 1" x 1" squares for Nine Patch Sawtooth Stars blocks.

✂ From binding fabric:

*Cut (3) $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips.



★ Fabrics & Cutting Instructions for 9" block ~ Quilt size 51" x 64" :

♥ $3\frac{1}{8}$ yards of light print for blocks, background & borders.

♥ (98) assorted 5" dark print squares and/or scraps for blocks.

♥ $\frac{1}{2}$ yard for binding.


♥ $3\frac{1}{2}$ yards for backing.

↻ Alternate Size Cutting Instructions ↻

✂ From the light print ~ for blocks, background, and borders:

*Cut (6) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for borders.

*Cut (3) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips ~ subcut (24) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for Double Nine Patch blocks.

*Cut (3) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips ~ subcut (24) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares ~ crosscut  once for Nine Patch Square in a Square units, in the Nine Patch Sawtooth Star blocks.

*Cut (4) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips ~ subcut (48) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for HST in Nine Patch Sawtooth Star blocks.

*Cut (8) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF strips ~ subcut (10) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " rectangles for side setting triangle blocks.

~ subcut (10) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5" rectangles for side setting triangle blocks.

~ subcut (4) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5" rectangles for corner setting triangle blocks.

~ subcut (48) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $2\frac{3}{4}$ " squares for Nine Patch Sawtooth Star blocks.

~ subcut (10) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $2\frac{3}{4}$ " squares for side setting triangle blocks.


*Cut (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips ~ subcut (48) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles for Double Nine Patch blocks.

*Cut (5) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips ~ subcut (72) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for Double Nine Patch blocks.

~ subcut (48) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for Nine Patch Sawtooth Stars blocks.

✂ From (98) assorted 5" dark print squares, and/or assorted scraps:

*Cut (48) assorted 3½" x 3½" squares for HST in Nine Patch Sawtooth Stars blocks.

*Cut (28) assorted 3⅛" x 3⅛" squares ~ crosscut once  diagonally for corner and side setting triangle blocks.

*Cut (102) assorted 1½" x 1½" squares for Double Nine Patch blocks.

*Cut (60) assorted 1½" x 1½" squares for Nine Patch Sawtooth Stars blocks.

✂ From binding fabric:

*Cut (6) 2¼" x WOF strips.

★Supplies You'll Need:

Tokens of the Past: Nine Patch Reverie pattern by Heartspun Quilts (available the day of class), click style pencil, basic sewing supplies, sewing machine in good working order, quarter inch foot for your machine, rotary cutter and medium size mat.

Please bring a 4½" square ruler. (I recommend Creative Grid rulers)

Optional, but very helpful is the Bloc-Loc 4½" Half Square Triangle ruler. I will have this ruler to try in class, and purchase if you so choose.
