## Mini-Quilt Curves Series **CRUISE SHIP - #1404**

A 15" square mini-quilt you can make in a day. Self-made bias tape covers the raw edges of curvy lines placed on a muslin foundation. Add some sew-and-flip sections to break up the space and add small pieces.

### Supplies:

15" - 18" square of freezer paper  
15" - 18" square of pre-shrunk muslin  
15" - 18" square of backing fabric  
15" square of thin, flat batting or flannel  
Thread in colors to match the bias strips  
Permanent black marking pen  
Opt. - Basting spray

**Fabric for Mini-Quilt:** Batiks, hand dyed fabrics and other contemporary cottons work well for your mini-quilt. Use the colors suggested by the cover photograph or customize your mini-quilt by choosing a unique, personal palette.

Fabric A - 5" x 10" piece  
B - 4" x 12" "  
C - 9" x 15" "  
D - 12" x 15" (enough for a matching bias strip)  
E - 4" x 45" piece  
F - 4" x 45" "  
G through Q - a 1 1/4" x 15" strip of each

5 pieces 1" wide bias-cut strips - 18-25" long (4 + D above)  
2 yards x 2" wide bias for quilt binding

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
