Mini-Quilt Curves Series **HIGH SEAS - #1402**

A 15" square mini-quilt you can make in a day. Self-made bias tape covers the raw edges of curvy lines placed on a muslin foundation. Add some sew-and-flip sections to break up the space and add small pieces.

Supplies:

- 17-18" square of freezer paper
- 17-18" square of preshrunk muslin
- 17-18" square of backing fabric
- 16" square of thin batting or flannel
- Thread in colors to match the bias strips
- Permanent extra-fine black marking pen
- Opt. - Temporary basting spray

Fabric for Mini-Quilt: Batiks, hand dyed fabrics and other contemporary cottons work well for your mini-quilt. Use the colors suggested by the cover photograph or customize your mini-quilt by choosing a unique, personal palette.

Fabric A - 4" x 9" piece
B - 3" x 11" "
C - 3" x 12" "
D - 3" x 12" "
E - 10" x 12" "
F - 16" x 11" "
G - 14" x 11" "
H, I - 2 1/4" x 12" each piece
J-P - 1 1/8" x 14" "
Q, R - 3" x 6" piece
S - 5" x 7" "
8 pieces 1" wide bias-cut strips 8"-28" long
2 strips 2" wide x width of the fabric
