Beth's mom sewed and taught her at a young age, and she also sewed for 4H. She mostly made garments until a friend encouraged her to visit Quilters Corner. She took Cyndi's Learn to Quilt series and found she enjoyed making quilts more than garments. She leans toward precision piecing and more traditional styles in quilting. Beth taught several friends to quilt and found it very rewarding. Now she enjoys teaching at Quilters Corner. She loves to show students that something they thought was difficult, is actually easier than they expected. She loves to help people try new things. Look for her classes on the Radiant Quilt and



Linda's Tech Corner

Quilters Corner offers sales and service of both Pfaff

and Baby Lock machines and service of most other brands. What can you do to maintain your machine between professional cleanings?

After each major sewing project, remove needle plate and remove lint and debris

from in and around the bobbin case and in between the feed dog teeth.

Change your needle – a general recommendation is after 6-8 hours of actual sewing time.

Use good quality thread to avoid unwanted thread "tangles," thread breakage and jams.

Use a compact, uniformly wound bobbin. Be sure the bobbin is the correct one for your machine.

When not in use, store your machine in a space free of humidity, with a cover. Put the needle in the down position and with a piece of fabric between the feed dogs, lower the presser foot.
