### Lavender Blueberry Cupcakes

makes 2 dozen

Linda worked on this recipe on and off for months, refining it to perfection. It's her favorite of the four featured cupcakes she made for her son's wedding reception this past July. They were a hit!

#### **Cupcakes:**

- 2-2/3 C unbleached flour
- 1-3/4 C sugar
- 1 T baking powder
- 1/2 t salt
- 12 T unsalted butter, softened and cut into cubes
- 4 egg whites
- 2 whole eggs
- 1/2 C whole milk
- 1/2 C buttermilk
- 2 t pure vanilla extract
- 1 t pure almond extract
- 2 C blueberries
- 1/4 C of dried lavender buds, cleaned of any stems & stalks

Pop your blueberries into the freezer about an hour before assembling your ingredients. Preheat oven to 350°. Prepare two 12-count Cupcake tins with liners. Sift flour & reserve 1/4 C. Combine flour, sugar, baking powder & salt in mixing bowl, add cubed butter and mix until crumbly. Mix in egg whites one at a time, followed by whole eggs one at a time, scraping edge of bowl as necessary. In a separate bowl, combine milk, buttermilk, almond, and vanilla extracts. Stir this mixture, about a 1/2 C at a time, into the flour mixture, until well combined. Remove blueberries from freezer & coat with reserved 1/4 C of flour. Add coated berries and dried lavender to the batter, mix only slightly until incorporated. Bake 15-20 minutes; do not brown.

#### Frosting:

- 8 oz. pkg cream cheese
- 6 T unsalted butter
- 2 T lemon zest
- 2 T fresh lemon juice
- 1 t pure vanilla extract
- 6-8 C powdered sugar

Beat cream cheese, butter, lemon juice, zest, and vanilla until combined. Add powdered sugar gradually; use less if you're are simply frosting with a knife, more if you are "piping" with a decorator tip. Wait till the cupcakes are thoroughly cooled before frosting. Refrigerate if not eating right away. Enjoy.

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
