BLOCKS OF THE MONTH TUXEDO'S TALES ANIMAL ADVENTURE APPLIQUÉ BLOCK OF THE MONTH



Calling all cat lovers! This adventurous cat wearing seasonal attire will charm your socks off. Tuxedo's Tales comes from designer Bonnie Sullivan of All Through the Night pattern company. Our sample is made with guilting cotton and can be appliqued by the method of your choice.

Each month for six months you will receive fabric and patterns for two blocks. The first month includes the button pack for the eyes and berries; the final sixth month includes all the fabric for the setting blocks and binding as well as complete assembly instructions in color. Each monthly packet is \$28.50. An optional thread pack is available for \$10.50 that consists of seven balls of size 12 pearl cotton to complete the simple embroidery details.


The finished size is 40" x 52". This program starts in October.

EMBROIDERY BLOCK OF THE MONTH



Machine embroidery enthusiasts, this block of the month is for you! Animal Adventure by Anita Goodesign is adorable. Our fabric kits make a wall hanging 31" x 38" with 10 different animals.
