Rhuberb Sauce

Rhubarb often emerges from the ground when there is a still a little snow left. The vibrant contrast of curly, bright green leaves and ruby red stalks against a blanket of white spring snow inspires us to pick a few stalks to create this tasty sauce. It is sweet & tart; you can increase the amount of sugar to taste.

Preparation time about 20 minutes

3 C rhubarb, cut into 1" pieces

1/2 C brown sugar, or to taste

1/4 C water

1/8 t freshly grated nutmeg (or use ground nutmeg)

1/4 t cinnamon

1/4 t vanilla extract

In a medium size sauce pan, combine the sugar, rhubarb, water & spices. Bring to a boil and reduce heat. Simmer about 10 minutes, or until the rhubarb is tender and begins to fall apart. Remove from heat and stir in the vanilla. Stir a little more to break up the rhubarb chunks and create a sauce-like consistency.

This sauce is quite versatile. Serve it over

waffles or pancakes.
Try it on your morning oatmeal. An all-time favorite is to spoon it warm over homemade vanilla ice cream.
Yummy! The recipe is easily doubled; it will keep in the refrigerator for up to two weeks.
