Flowering Wreath features a vibrant garland of appliquéd flowers. The pattern includes instructions for fusible, raw edge and needle turn appliqué. This quilt is a wonderful opportunity to use the beautiful decorative stitches on your machine. Look for a class from Kristin to explore these methods and learn a few tricks she used when creating the sample. Use your own fabrics or pick up a kit. The kit contains all the fabrics you need for the flowers, leaves and buds and has plenty of fabric to make the size quilt you choose – lap, full, or queen – plus enough to add more flowers if you like. The background fabric will be your choice and the amount you need will depend on the size quilt you are making. Acrylic templates of all the appliqué shapes are available, or you can create your own from the shapes included in the pattern.





**Flourish** is another beauty from Nancy Rink, the designer of many quilts including Getting to Know Hue and Amish With a Twist IV. It's irresistable, with an elegant feathered star center, simple appliqué, and a sublime color palette. There are two size options, 58" square and 88" square. We have made our sample 58" square and have kits for both sizes because we know many of you will want to make the larger size.

Nancy Rink has truly outdone herself with this Amish-inspired block of the month design! It merges elements of a traditional Amish Trip Around the World with a unique center star and a variety of colorful blocks, all set against a black background. Nancy's careful color placement gives each block a beautiful floating, dimensional twist. The twelve month program began in January. The cost is \$14.99 monthly for the kits and \$30 for the pattern booklet which includes three additional quilt patterns. We also have complete kits available. The finished quilt size is 88" x 98".



With the Tree Topper & Ornament Pattern, you can make two-sided dimensional stars for all seasons. Make tree toppers & ornaments for friends & family, but don't limit yourself to just Christmas. These fun stars in three sizes

would be great in a child's room or as seasonal accents in your home. Want some help getting started? Look for a class from Kristin.

The Pin Place/Scissor Spot magnet holds your scissors securely with the handles ready to grab. Press the suction cup onto the side of your machine or locate it just above your sewing machine presser foot and instantly



deposit pulled-out pins as you keep sewing. This powerful little holder is strong enough to hold thread, scissors, or even full size cutting shears. What a convenient way to stay orderly as you sew! This has long been one of Kristin's favorites.

The String Thing is a metal tin with a magnetized lid. It's just the thing for keeping your hand sewing thread, needle, and scissors tidy and contained. We have two sizes, one that is perfect for a ball of pearl cotton and a larger one
