Resolution or no resolution, we are here to help you with your projects. Please don't forget to bring them in to Quilters Corner to show off!




Cat's Meow

CONTINUING BLOCK-OF-THE-MONTH



We've taken a simple double-four-patch block and made this striking Block-of-the-Month quilt. The piecing is a cinch; the color selection makes the quilt. Every month for nine months you will make eight different colored blocks with our beautiful batik selections. Your finished quilt will be 80" x 90". The pattern is \$9.00. Monthly kits are \$20 per month for nine months; binding is included in the last kit.



Cat's Meow is a machine embroidery design, but can also be done with fusible appliqué. Whether you are a cat lover or know someone who loves cats, this quilt is a must have. Seven adorable embroidery appliqué cats and five additional cat-related designs adorn this 53" x 60" quilt. The designs can also be used for smaller quilts and to embellish clothing and household items. The pattern is \$50 and includes the designs on a USB drive. The fabric kits are \$18 per month for six months and include border and binding. Thread kits are available for \$45. The minimum hoop size for this quilt is 6" x 9-3/4". This block of the month started in October and will continue through April. Look for Gail's Cat's Meow class.

NEW PATTERNS







The work of designer Vanessa Happ is one of our best Quilt Market finds. Not only are the designs beautiful, but there's guite a story behind them. In the 1930's, Vanessa's husband's grandfather Carl Happ owned a factory in Berlin that stamped linens with embroidery designs for hand embroidery. The family escaped Germany to the Netherlands at the onset of WWII taking the designs with them. These three patterns (and a new block of the month we will be doing here at Quilters Corner in the spring) were adapted from these original designs. Brynne made our samples using fused appliqué; they can also be done using hand appliqué or by embroidery machine in the hoop. Simply gorgeous!

Nantucket is our latest sample made from Moda's ever popular French General line of fabrics. It is fat quarter friendly and easy enough for a beginner. The finished quilt is 67" x 67"; kit available.





Use your leftover strips of fabric to make a wallet, change purse and eye glass case. **Little Bits** is even more fun when you use decorative threads and fancy machine stitches. For a complete matching ensemble, add the 14" x 7" x 5" **Sophia** handbag.



Make these **Snappy Slippers** and their cute travel bag with one package of forty 5" charm squares. Full sized templates included for ladies' sizes 5-11.

Our sample of **Twirl** is so fun and cute, made with polka dots that dance and spin in glorious bright colors. The pattern is easy, using only a few simple cuts and minimal piecing. This quilt uses the Creative Grids Straight Out of Line ruler. The finished size is 59" x 76"; kit available. Look for a class from Kristin.





Courthouse Stars would make a great focal point for any room. 5" star blocks checkerboarded with Courthouse Steps blocks & finished off with a scrappy piano key border make a very striking statement. Our sample, made from Jo Morton fabrics, features warm shades of red, tan, and green. The finished quilt is 45" x 55"; kit available.

In **Hunter's Star Simplified**, a classic quilt pattern has been modified so there are no

diamonds to cut or Y seams to sew – it is all half square triangles and squares. The pattern includes seven different sizes from a table runner to a king size quilt – you may find that one quilt is not enough! Choose our scrappy batik version (kit available) or simplify even further and make a two color quilt.






Recipe!

Roasted Butternut Squash Soup

1 medium butternut squash

Olive oil or butternut squash seed oil (available at F Oliver's, located on the Commons in Ithaca)

2-3 cups vegetable broth 1/2 cup butter Salt and Pepper


1 cup 1/2 & 1/2 cream 1-2 cloves of garlic Fresh ground nutmeg

Step 1: Cut squash in half, remove seeds, place cut side down on cookie sheet. Using your hands coat squash with oil. Add water to cover bottom of pan and come up the sides of the squash about 1/4". Roast in the oven1 hour at 300 degrees. Skin should be golden brown and start to bubble slightly to get that nice roasted flavor. Add water to the pan as necessary.

Step 2: Remove squash from oven, let cool and scoop squash leaving the skin. Place squash in soup pot, add pressed garlic, salt & pepper. Add 2 c. broth and 1/2 & 1/2. Using a stick blender or regular blender, process until larger chunks of squash are gone. Using low to med heat, heat til it simmers, add more broth to achieve desired consistency. Cook for about 10 min. Season soup with about 1/2 t. nutmeg.

Step 3: Serve with a dollop of sour cream & croutons.

Growing up on a farm, this was one of my favorite soups. We had all the ingredients readily available and it was fairly easy to make. You can use the same recipe with most winter squash, including pumpkin.
