
I started sewing when I was about 12 years old. making doll clothes. I also enjoyed counted cross stitch, embroidery and knitting, and taught myself how to do all of those things. That experience taught me the value of taking classes! I always admired quilts and decided that if I was ever going to have the kinds that I liked, I would probably have to make them myself. So I took my first quilting class – 23 years ago. My tools were a pencil, scissors, ruler, fabric, needle and thread no rotary cutter or sewing machine. Everything was done by hand. I learned a lot. I later learned that I love my rotary cutter and my sewing machine! However, my early interest in needle work was the foundation for my love of hand appliqué, so now my favorite thing is to combine hand work with machine piecing. I like exploring all the different ways to play with fabric and have a little reputation for embellishing with beads, ribbon and glitter. What isn't made better with a little bit of sparkle? I continue to take classes on a wide variety of quilting techniques and always take something away from each class and instructor. I also love to teach others and spread the joy of creating something beautiful by hand.
