
Machine embroidery enthusiasts, this is for you! **Animal Adventure** by Anita Goodesign is adorable. Our wall hanging is 31" x 38" with 10 different animals.

The Animal Adventure collection includes a 150+ page full color tutorial book and a multipleformat design CD with 15 different animals, 8 different quilt blocks per animal and 9 different embroidery designs per animal – that's 250+ designs in all. With so many designs and options, you will be able to make the wall hanging as well as embroider these lovable animals onto anything from a onesie to a t-shirt, a bib to an apron, a diaper bag to a backpack - the ideas are endless! The Animal Adventure collection is \$250. Kits are \$9/month and include all the fabric for the animals, the background, sashing, and binding. A thread pack of all ten colors of embroidery thread needed is \$45. This ten month program started in October and continues through July. Sign up today!

Gudrun Erla, the designer and owner of GE Designs, was born and raised in Iceland and now lives in Minnesota. She started quilting at the age of 23 and became totally addicted to it right away. She loves everything quick and simple but her designs don't always look that way. She designed the **Stripology Ruler** to make cutting fast and accurate and has written several books and patterns based on strips and 5" and 10" squares. Those of you who have the ruler already know how useful, fast and accurate it is. Gudrun started playing around with the ruler, using it in other ways than to just cut strips, squares and rectangles and she has created many interesting

and fun patterns.

The smaller size is
easier to manipulate
and more portable so
it's the perfect choice to



take to classes and retreats. Follow the easy to read markings that make it a cinch to cut strips and squares. The ruler also includes markings to square up half-square triangles and blocks up to 12-1/2". The slots are longer to accommodate larger blocks and cut wider fabrics.

Her new **Stripology Squared** book has complicated looking quilts that come together with ease in no time. A bonus is that each one uses 10" squares, so dive into your stash of precuts or cut your own squares using the **Stripology Squared**



Ruler. There are 10 different quilt patterns, each with instructions for making crib to king size quilts. Check out the great YouTube videos featuring the designs from this book, and come in for a demo.

Ruler or the Stripology



The **Stripology 2** book has six patterns (3 sizes for each) that use 1-½" strips. We created a kit using the **Strip Twist** pattern and 64 different gorgeous prints from the Kaffe Fassett Collective. The best part is that we used the Stripology Ruler and have done a lot of the cutting for you!

The Sweetheart Swing Bag is playful, pleated and fabulous for every occasion.



The **Boxy Tote** is perfect for toting the Singer



Featherweight! There are pockets all the way around on the outside and on the inside to fill with sewing supplies, cosmetics, travel accessories, etc. Heavy duty stays (included with the pattern) keep the bags mouth wide open and make it easy to reach in and grab what you need.

Make a plush, quilted pet bed for your best friend in two sizes: small (up to 12 lbs) and bigger (up to 25 lbs). **Pieceful Pet Beds** includes directions to make the bed, pieced blocks to make the pillow, and cute dog, cat (and mouse!) appliqués.



The Sew Kind of Wonderful sisters have yet again produced several new charming patterns using the Quick Curve Ruler and the Mini Quick Curve Ruler. Mod Owls, Mod Strawberries and Mod Pineapples are simply yummy.



Urbanologie is their new

sampler pattern. There are 12 different themed blocks including houses, birds, flowers and more, that may be used to create a sampler quilt. They have included three different layouts or choose your favorite block(s) and create your own design.



One of our favorite finds from Quilt Market is a series of patterns with gorgeous birds and flowers designed by Darcy Ashton from Anna's Awesome Appliqué. They are written for embroidery machines but all the patterns are available in a booklet for traditional

appliqué. In fact, the original designs were completed by hand and Anna digitized them for hooped embroidery. They are simply beautiful! Embroidery formats: ART, EXP, JEF, PES, VP3. Cutting machine formats: FCM, JPEG, PDF, SVG. Look for samples soon...

We liked the simple and charming designs for the ten animal faces in Whimsical Woodland Faces. They are suitable for hand, machine or fusible appliqué. Make a quilt or use individual blocks to create a Woodland Faces quilted quiet book. Ask for the free book pattern.



Laura Heine of Fiberworks has designed over 25 different collage patterns. Many of you have taken a class with Valerie Leftwich here at the shop, and the quilts you have produced have been wonderful and unique.

Laura has a new collage pattern, **Making Fish**. It includes instructions for creating very handsome fish and incorporating them into four 14" x 22" placemats. After you learn how to make the fish you can create

table runners, wall hangings or quilts.

Laura's **Little Book of Collage** supplements her patterns and helps you develop your own

patterns. It gives step by step instruction on her collage techniques, color and value, what fabrics work well, those that blend or stand alone and those that absolutely do not work. This is a great resource if you are not able to attend a class or if you need reminders and tips after a class. Laura's booth at Quilt Market had several other



new (non-collage)
patterns; pieced, paper
pieced and appliqué,
that we loved and had
to bring back to you. My
Kinda Town features
scrappy houses and
trees; Audubon Society
features pieced birds in
a tree and Woodlands
is a lovely appliqué
with creatures from the
forest.

Floor Tiles is a new rug pattern from Aunties Two that uses fabric squares and fusible foam batting. The floor tiles are based on 6" fabric squares but you can use the technique with any size. Use the rug anywhere you'd like to add color or protect your flooring.



Gather up 12 light fat quarters and 12 dark fat quarters from your stash or choose a pack that we've selected, to create Maybe I'm Amazed. It couldn't be simpler and would be interesting in many styles of fabric.



Patternworkz Design Studio impressed us with their wonderful designs and the multiple variations possible with each pattern depending on fabric choices. The stash busting potential is incredible and the patterns are well written, with clear illustrations.



Modern Mingle, with sizes from lap to king offers endless outcomes. Use two fabrics or two hundred; this pattern easily adapts to a brand new fabric collection or you can dive into your stash. Look for a sample and kit soon.

String piecing has long been a scrap savers favorite. **Fassenating Pinwheels** was designed to use up bits and pieces that are too good to throw out but never seem to get used. Caution!
This can be addictive.
A ruler is available to



simplify cutting but it is not required.

Japanese Windows is 102" x 102" but could



easily be adapted to any size. The designer used upwards of a hundred different fabrics for this large, scrappy, gorgeous quilt!

Other patterns available from Patternworkz include **Bladez** and

String Stars. We loved them all!

Free motion quilting not for you? How about some "forward motion" quilting? Get that walking foot out of the ditch, take it for a drive and see what that baby can really do! Walk Master Machine Quilting with Your Walking Foot by

Jacquie Gering will be

your guide. You'll work your way from walking foot basics to intricate marked designs as you master machine quilting with your walking foot.



In Quilt with Tula and Angela two of the biggest celebrities in quilting take the guesswork out of color, shape and line, giving their brilliant aesthetic punch to 17 quilt patterns. This start to finish guide includes essentials on tools, quilting, backing and binding, plus 24 quilting motifs.

Tula Pink's unique and innovative approach to color will give you a comprehensive color education. Angela Walters gives clear advice on quilting to lend surface interest to every project - no vague advice to, "quilt as desired"!
