11 QUILTING AND SEWING RESOLUTIONS FOR 2018

Are you making resolutions for 2018? We aren't going to tell you how to get physically fit or improve your character, but we do have some suggestions that will help you enjoy your sewing even more.

- Clean my sewing machine frequently. A buildup of lint can cause stitching problems.
- 2. Close the guard on my rotary cutter before it leaves my hand. Every. Time.
- 3. Spend some time sewing at least four days a week, even if it's just half an hour. Those little bits will add up to big results.
- Label my quilts with at least my name, the year, and where it was made.
- 5. Learn a new skill. Take a class; try that new tool!
- 6. Teach someone to sew. It's a useful skill for everyone.
- 7. Sew something for charity.
- Get together with other sewers. Join a guild, come to Open Sewing, or get together with friends who sew.
- **9. Seek out inspiration.** Go to shows, visit Quilters Corner to check out the latest samples, read quilting books and magazines.
- **10. Don't beat myself up when I make a mistake.** This is a good one for outside the realm of sewing as well!
- 11. Give my sewing some dedicated space in my home. Even if you don't set aside a whole room, having an area where you can leave a work-in-progress undisturbed saves time when you are ready to resume working on it.



Our newest Block-of-the-Month program, **Starfall**, is made with a lovely array of grays, taupes, and tans as the background and rich, vibrant colors for the varied stars. At 72" x 92", this contemporary guilt is perfect for a dorm room, guest room, or that special someone's bed. We have adapted the Starfall pattern to be a six month program. Each month you will piece a different style and size star; the last month you will receive the filler fabric along with directions and fabric for the borders & binding that we've added to make the quilt twin size. The kits are \$24 per month; the pattern is sold separately for \$9. This program starts in January and continues through June.

Enjoy the rich colors of Hometown Village, designed by Brynne Sigg of Royal Quilt Designs. Build your town with lovely reds, warm golds, beautiful greens, and country blues. You will sew your quilt row by row. Start with a starry sky in shades of blue, then stitch flower baskets, a row of houses, fall leaves, tessellated trees, and several checkerboard and flying geese rows. The finished guilt is 72" x 92" which fits nicely on a twin bed. This eight month Block-of-the-Month program is \$24 per month. The single pattern is \$12, and is available separately. The program started in October and continues through May. We still have a few kits available; call us at 607-266-0850 to sign up today.







incorporated into other quilt projects.

The pattern is \$20 and the wool fabric kit is \$65. You may also want the pack of 12 coordinating Valdani pearl cotton threads, \$60. Valdani threads are hand-dyed by highly skilled artisans; these environmentally friendly threads are simply gorgeous. Pat is offering classes on the simple embroidery stitches and block construction.

Anna Marie Horner has created a new line of clothing patterns she calls **Simple Start**. They are easy and meant to build your sewing skills as you create something fun and pretty to wear. Skills featured include bias bound facings, dolman sleeves, curved hems, french seams, and inset gore piecing.
