

NIGHT WATCHMAN CONTINUING BLOCK OF THE MONTH



This block-of-the-month features some of our favorite woodland animals – a fox, an owl, fireflies, birds, a bear and more. All the fabric is batik with a modern flavor and glowing with the beautiful colors of nature. The animals are fused appliqué blocks and are interspersed with pieced blocks to create a lovely 50" x 66" finished quilt. The program started in September 2019 and runs for 12 months. The monthly fee is \$18.99; all the fabric for the quilt top plus binding as well as patterns is included. You will receive full color step-by-step instructions, detailed graphics, reversed appliqué pages, plus seven inserts for positioning the appliqué. The pattern is available separately for \$42.

We would like to showcase the talent that our customers have shown us over the years. In that spirit, we are doing a quilt challenge.

Here's how it works:

- To participate, purchase a fabric pack with a fat 1/16th of each of the two challenge fabrics to be used in your quilt. The cost is \$1.99. The rest of the fabric will be up to you.
- Each of these two fabrics must be in your quilt and each fabric should have at least a 1" x 2" piece showing.
- Each quilt must be no more than 15" long and no more than 15" wide. They can be smaller, but please no larger than 15". They do not have to be the same dimension on each side; they can be a rectangle or whatever shape you like.
- The due date is June 30th. We will have all the challenge quilts on display for our July 25 Birthday Party.
- The quilt should have three layers: top, some sort of middle layer (batting) and backing.
- Each quilt should have something to anchor those layers together: example - quilting or tying.
- Anything goes as far as design: traditional, modern, landscape, portrait...
- Your quilt must have your name and telephone number on the back for return. Your quilt will remain at Quilters Corner though the rest of 2020 to help us celebrate all year long.
- There will be no winners or losers. All participants will receive a gift from Quilters Corner.

Another wonderful animal pattern by Elizabeth Hartman, designer of Fancy Forest, is available. **Spectacular Savanna** features African animals – an elephant, zebra, giraffe, lion, rhino, gazelle, hippo, and wildebeest. The 64" x 84" sampler quilt uses traditional patchwork



piecing – no paper piecing or appliqué. The pattern also includes complete instructions for making a variety of quilts and quilted pillow covers using individual animal and leaf blocks. We have a kit available for the quilt top – come in to see the sample. We think you'll love it!



The Quilt Factory has created several easy quilt patterns that feature cute animals with sweet sayings, perfect for baby. Each pattern requires 1-½ yards for the whole cloth background and small pieces for the animals to be appliqued using your favorite method. The patterns include a lamb,

fox, kitten, puppy, whale, dinosaur, swan, and sloth. Cyndi *Sloth*ower had to make the sloth, of course, and we have created a kit based on her sample that includes cuddly Minkee for the sloth body. Each quilt measures 42" x 52".

Winterberry Café by Sue Pritt is sure to be welcome in any home. This 18" x 27" wall hanging of native birds at a birdfeeder uses an easy fusible appliqué technique. The pattern includes pre-fused, lasercut appliqué shapes (for the tiny black accents only). Our kit includes everything else to make the quilt top plus binding.



New from Sew Kind of Wonderful

Many of you will be familiar with the Quick Curve Ruler (QCR) and the Mini QCR. We have enjoyed using both rulers and have created quite a few samples from the many available patterns and books. When a new ruler was introduced at Quilt Market called the **Wonder Curve Ruler** (WCR), we were excited to see what it could do.

Happy Together and Cool Cars, two new patterns using the WCR, are so adorable that we couldn't resist. Both have many possibilities

to personalize for a favorite child. The 6" x 10" ruler has colored lines and markings which make it wonderfully simple to make a combination of curved blocks that are used repeatedly in WCR patterns. The three bold colored lines make it easy to scale a block larger or smaller just by aligning fabric with the different colors and

Make a working clock to match any decor. Stitch



in Time and Cuckoo Clock are simple patterns that use either an artist's canvas or an embroidery hoop along with a battery-operated clock mechanism. Simple piecing or fusible appliqué completes the design. At Quilt Market in Houston in October, one thing was abundantly clear – hand stitching is alive and well! We saw many examples of English Paper Piecing (EPP), wool appliqué, embroidery and more. Here are some of the fun things we think you will enjoy during the cold winter months, curled up in an easy chair with some stitching. If you'd like a little help getting started, we have classes that feature handwork.

For quick and easy stitchery, try our mini embroidery patterns from Hugs 'n Kisses. Each pattern includes one tiny adorable design and one iron-on transfer. Stitch with perle cotton or floss, then tuck it in a frame, stitch on clothing, feature it on a bag, or use in any quilt project. Check out our selection of little wooden frames – so perfect for displaying tiny embroidery. Some of the frames could even be made into necklaces and pins. Mandalas to Embroider is a little book with a collection of 24 designs. Mandala is the Sanskrit word for 'circle' and has significant spiritual and symbolic meaning. These days it is often used as a generic term for a concentric design or one that radiates from the center. Sitting guietly focusing on stitching can be relaxing and meditative. The book



contains detailed instructions and diagrams of the ten key stitches used. Detachable, iron-on transfers are included that can be used up to ten times.



Wool Needle & Thread by Lisa Bongean of Primitive Gatherings is your new go-to guide for wool stitchery. This book is brimming with dozens of step-by-step photos, streamlined stitching tricks, and professional finishing techniques. She starts with tips, favorite tools and needles, and then continues with her techniques for creating slim vines, pretty pennies, and beautiful flower appliqués. Lisa shares five sweet projects that will teach you how to start, stitch, and finish your projects more accurately, more confidently, and more beautifully than ever before. Look for a kit to create the pincushion project and a pincushion class from Pat. A kit will be available that includes everything you need for the project.

Hugs 'n Kisses Christmas Club Table Runner is a quick and lovely project to make for a mantle, small ledge, or table. EPP iron-on hexies and appliqué paper are included in the pattern. Look for a class from Kristin who will show you how easy it is to use appliqué paper and a glue stick to



pre-turn raw edges to make appliqué a snap. Pattern and kit available.






