


Fabric & Cutting Chart

Fabric	Yardage	Cutting Directions
Fabric A SB20417-760	1y (1 panel)	Quilt center (1) 34 ½" x 40 ½" rectangle, centering design.
Fabric B SB20053-101	1 1/8y	a. Sashing (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Subcut (1) 1 ½" x 40 ½" strip. b. Tree blocks (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (12) 1 ½" x 8 ½" rectangles then (12) 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares (1) 1 ¾" x WOF strip. Subcut (12) 1 ¾" x 3" rectangles. (2) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Subcut (12) 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares. c. Fence blocks (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (32) 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares and (8) 1 ½" x 3 ½" rectangles. (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 2 ½" x 3 ½" and (8) 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles. d. Outer border (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 2 ½" x 44 ½" and (2) 2 ½" x 53 ½" strips.
Fabric C SB20053-280	3/8y	a. Tree blocks (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Subcut (6) 1 ½" x 1 ¾" rectangles. b. Fence blocks (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Subcut (16) 1 ½" x 2" rectangles. (1) 2" x WOF strip. Subcut (8) 2" x 2 ½" rectangles. (2) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Subcut (8) 2 ½" x 8 ½" rectangles.


Fabric D SB20103-760	1/2y	Binding (6) 2 ¼" x WOF strips. Piece strips to make a binding strip.
Fabric E SB20104 -835 Fabric F SB20171 -815 Fabric G SB20415 -815	1/4y each	Tree blocks (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip from each fabric. Subcut (2) 6 ½" x 7 ¼" rectangles.
Fabric H SB20268-310	1/8y	Sashing (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips Subcut (2) 1 ½" x 40 ½" strips.

Constructing tree blocks


1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B square. Place square, right sides together, at the top left corner of (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (horizontal) x 7 $\frac{1}{4}$ " (vertical) green rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with an additional 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B at the top right corner, and (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B squares at the bottom left and right corners of the same green rectangle.




2. Sew (2) 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 3" Fabric B rectangles to the opposite sides of (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric C rectangle to make a row unit. Sew row unit to the bottom of step 1 unit to make a tree unit. Unit measures 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.



3. Sew (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B rectangles to the left and right sides of step 2 unit to complete (1) block. Block measures 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.



4. Make a total of (2) blocks each for Fabric E, F, G:



Constructing fence blocks


1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 1 ½" x 1 ½" Fabric B square. Place square, right sides together, at the top left corner of (1) 2 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric C rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim ¼" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with an additional 1 ½" x 1 ½" Fabric B square at the top right corner. Make a total of (2) units.	
2. Sew together (2) 2" x 2 ½" Fabric C and (2) 1 ½" x 2 ½" Fabric B rectangles alternating, to make a sewn unit. Add (1) 2 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric B rectangle to the top of unit.	
3. Sew together (2) 1 ½" x 2" Fabric C and (2) 1 ½" x 1 ½" Fabric B squares, alternating, to make a sewn unit. Add (1) 1 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric B rectangle to the top of unit. Make a total of (2) units.	
4. Sew step 1 units to the opposite sides of step 2 units, followed by step 3 units to the opposite sides to complete (1) block. Block measures 8 ½" x 8 ½" unfinished. Make a total of (4) blocks.	

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
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Quilt Top Assembly

1. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to the top, and (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the bottom of (1) 34 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A rectangle.



2. Refer to quilt image for block placement. Arrange and sew together (3) tree blocks and (2) fence blocks to make a pieced row. Make (2) pieced rows and add to the top and bottom of quilt center.



3. Add (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to the bottom of quilt center. Sew (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 53 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 44 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.



Finishing

- 1. Layer backing, batting and quilt top.
- 2. Baste the layers together. Quilt as desired.
- 3. Bind to complete the quilt.
