Nose to Nose

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

Fabric A - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 8-1/2" x 79" and (2) 8-1/2" x 63" multi-stripe borders

Fabric B - Fussy cut (12) 8-3/4" squares with motifs centered

Fabric C - Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (6) 4-1/2" squares

Fabric D - Cut (2) 2-7/8" strips, subcut (24) 2-7/8" squares then cut in half $/\!\!/$ diagonally for a total of 48 triangles Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (34) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" and (68) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric E - Cut (4) 2-7/8" strips, subcut (48) 2-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for a total of 96 triangles Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (34) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces and (68) 2-1/2" squares Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric F - Cut (5) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 56-1/2" and (2) 2" x 43-1/2" borders

Fabric G - Cut (6) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (68) 3-1/2" squares, (1) 2-1/2" square, and (4) 1-1/2" squares Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (16) 2-1/2" squares Cut (5) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (140) 1-1/2" squares

Fabric H - Cut (1) 5-1/4" strip, subcut (6) 5-1/4" squares then cut in half \times diagonally twice for a total of 24 triangles Cut (5) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (72) 2-1/2" squares Cut (5) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (136) 1-1/2"

Shading of diagrams may vary depending on fabrics used.

2. Piecing Order:


1. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of all **Fabrics G** and **H** 1-1/2" squares and Fabrics D and E 2-1/2" squares.




Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

2. Mark the 4-3/8" center point on all sides of a 8-3/4" Fabric B square as shown. Draw diagonal lines from mark to mark. Trim corners from square. Repeat for a total of 12 trimmed **B** squares (6-1/8" square unfinished).

3. Arrange 2 Fabric G 1-1/2" squares on opposite corners of a







Make 72

Fabric H 2-1/2" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out. Make a total of 72 Unit 1 (2-1/2" square unfinished).

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

4. In the same manner, make 68 Unit 2 (3-1/2" square unfinished) with 1 each Fabrics D and E 2-1/2" squares and a Fabric G 3-1/2" square.

5. Sew 2 **Fabric E** 2-7/8" triangles to adjoining sides of a Unit 1 as shown. Make a total of 48 Unit 3 $(4-7/8" \times 4-7/8" \times 6-7/8" \text{ unfinished}).$



6. Sew 4 Unit 3 to all sides of a **B** 6-1/8" square as shown. Make a total of 12 Block 1 (8-1/2" square unfinished).





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7. Sew 2 **Fabric D** 2-7/8" triangles to short edges of a **Fabric H** 5-1/4" triangle. Make a total of 24 Unit 4 (2-1/2" x 4-1/2" unfinished).



8. Arrange 1 **Fabric C** 4-1/2" square and 4 each Units 1 and 4 in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 6 **Block 2** (8-1/2" square unfinished).



9. Arrange 1 marked **Fabric H** 1-1/2" square on 1 corner of a








Fabric D 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" piece as Make 34 Make 34 shown. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4" and press triangle out.
Repeat on adjoining corner of Fabric D piece.
Make a total of 34 Unit 5a (2-1/2" x 3-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 34 Unit 5b with fabrics indicated.

10. Arrange 1 **Fabric G** 2-1/2" square, 4 Unit 2, and 2 each Units 5a and 5b in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 17 **Block 3** (8-1/2" square unfinished).




- 11. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.
- 12. Arrange blocks in 7 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center $(40-1/2^{\circ} \times 56-1/2^{\circ} \times 10^{\circ})$.
- 13. Sew **Fabric F** 2" x 56-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric F** 2" x 43-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

14. Center **Fabric A** 8-1/2" x 79" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and **Fabric A** 8-1/2" x 63" borders on top and bottom of quilt center with the narrow stripe next to quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric. Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

15. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



- 16. The quilt measures approximately 59-1/2" x 75-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric I**) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 17. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric E**) and enjoy!!


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QUILT LAYOUT




