## Cutting Directions:

| Black | GO! <br> Cleopatra's <br> Fan | Cut 1-complete Cleopatra's Fan block*. | 1 yards |
| Black | $\searrow^{3}$ | Cut 3—71/4" $x$ width of fabric (WOF) strips. Fan fold $71 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ widths. Cut $24-6$ " finished half square triangles (HST). | Yardage included above |
| White | GO! <br> Cleopatra's <br> Fan | Cut 1-complete Cleopatra's Fan block*. | $3 / 4$ yards |
| White | GO! Strip Cutter $11 / 2$ " <br> (1" Finished) | Cut 4—11⁄2" strips for borders. | Yardage included above |
| Gray | GO! <br> Cleopatra's <br> Fan | Cut 1-complete Cleopatra's Fan block*. | 11/4 yards |
| Gray | GO! Strip Cutter 2½" (2" Finished) | Cut 5-2½" strips for borders. | Yardage included above |

* For one complete block: Cut $1-13 \frac{1}{2} / 2 \times 10$ " rectangle. Fold in half on the long edge and lay on shapes A, C and F. Cut $1-16 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 8$ " rectangle fold in half on the long edge and lay on shapes I, F and G. Cut $1-21 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 7 \frac{1}{4}$ " rectangle fold on the long edge in half and lay on shapes $\mathrm{J}, \mathrm{H}, \mathrm{D}$ and B . Place mat over fabric and die. Run through cutter.

- Use GO! Strip Cutter 2½" (2"

Finished) (55017 or 55014) to cut 5$21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for binding.

## Additional Fabrics Needed:



- Batting: 28" x 62"
- Backing: 2 yards


## Sewing Directions:

Press all seams open and use $1 / 4$ " seams, unless otherwise indicated.
Directions will be for one 12" finished block. Make 3 different colored blocks.


1. Block 1: Sew grey shape $A$ and black shape $B$ together, one being a mirror image. Press towards shape A on the left side and press towards shape $B$ on the right side.
Block 2: Sew black shape A and white shape B together. Block 3: Sew white shape A and grey shape B together.

2. Block 1: Sew grey shape $C$ and black shape $D$ together, one being a mirror image. Press towards shape D on the left side and press towards shape C on the right side.
Block 2: Sew black shape C and white shape D together.
Block 3: Sew white shape C and grey shape D together.

3. Block 1: Sew white shape $E$ to unit $C / D$ from Step 2. One will be a mirror image. Press towards shape E on the left side and press towards unit $\mathrm{C} / \mathrm{D}$ on the right side.
Block 2: Sew grey shape E and unit C/D together.
Block 3: Sew black shape $E$ and unit C/D together.

4. Block 1: Sew grey shape $F$ and white shape $G$ together, one being a mirror image. Press towards shape $F$ on the left side and press towards shape $G$ on the right side.
Block 2: Sew black shape F and grey shape G together.
 Block 3: Sew white shape F and black shape $G$ together.
5. Block 1: Sew black shape $H$ to unit $F / G$ from Step 4. One will be a mirror image. Press towards unit F/G on the left side and press towards shape H on the right side.
Block 2: Sew white shape $H$ and unit F/G together.


Block 3: Sew grey shape $E$ and unit F/G together.
6. Block 1: Sew white shape I to unit F/G/H from Step 5 . One will be a mirror image. Press towards shape I on the left side and press towards unit F/G/H on the right side.
Block 2: Sew grey shape I and unit F/G/H together.
Block 3: Sew black shape I and unit F/G/H together.

7. 1: Sew black shape $J$ to unit $F / G / H / I$ from Step 6 . One will be a mirror Block image. Press towards shape $J$ on the left side and press towards unit $\mathrm{F} / \mathrm{G} / \mathrm{H} / \mathrm{I}$ on the right side.
Block 2: Sew white shape $J$ and unit $F / G / H / I$ together.
Block 3: Sew grey shape $J$ and unit $F / G / H / I$ together.

8. Sew unit $A / B$ to the side of unit $C / D / E$. One will be a mirror image. Press seams open. Repeat with all 3 blocks.

9. Sew unit $A / B / C / D / E$ to unit $F / G / H / / / J$. One will be a mirror image. Press seams open. Repeat with all 3 blocks.

10. Sew block halves together. Press seams open.


## Setting Triangle Blocks

1. Sew two black 6 " finished half square triangles together on the short side as shown. Make 12 pairs.

## Assemble Quilt Blocks and Borders

1. Pin and sew four setting triangles to the sides of each Cleopatra's Fan block as shown.
2. Lay out blocks as shown. Pin and sew blocks together as shown with the middle block with the black background.
3. For inner border, use the GO! Strip Cutter- $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ (1" Finished) (55024) to cut $4 — 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " white strips. Cut $1-1 \frac{1}{2}$ " strip in half and then sew to two white
 strips. Trim to $51 \frac{1}{2}$ " and sew to the sides of the quilt. Press towards the strips.
4. Trim remaining two white strips into $2-191 / 2$ " lengths and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.
5. For outer border, use the GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014) to 5-212" grey strips. Cut one grey strip in half and then sew to the ends of two grey strips. Trim to $531 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ and sew to the sides of the quilt. Press towards the outer border.
6. Trim remaining two strips into $2-231 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ lengths and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.


## Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between wall hanging and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add gray binding, mitering corners.
