FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- Fabric 1—½ yard
- Fabric 2—¼ yard
- Fabric 3—1¹/₄ yards
- Fabric 4—¼ yard or fat quarter
- Fabric 5—1/4 yard or fat quarter
- Fabric 6—1/8 yard
- Fabric 7—1/8 yard
- Fusible web—1 yard
- Batting-30" x 30"
- Pillow form—24" x 24"

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

Apply fusible web to the wrong side of selected fabrics following manufacturer's instructions for appliqué shapes.

Fabric 1:

- Cut 4—8½" squares
- Cut 18—2½" squares

Fabric 2:

- Cut 18—2½" squares
- Cut 3—flower centers

Fabric 3:

- Cut 2—18" x 24½" rectangles for pillow back
- Cut 4—2½" strips across the width of the fabric for border Sub cut into $2-2^{1/2}$ " x $24^{1/2}$ " rectangles; and 2—2½" x 20½" rectangles
- Cut 2—flowers
- Cut 2—flower centers

Fabric 4:

• Cut 2—flowers

Fabric 5:

• Cut 3—flowers

Fabric 6:

Cut 7—leaves

Fabric 7:

• Cut 7—leaves

SEWING DIRECTIONS

- Pin and sew four Fabric #1, 8½" squares together to form a 4-Patch block. Press seams open.
- 2. Remove paper backing from appliqué shapes.
- 3. Lay out shapes on pieced 4-Patch block following pillow diagram.
- 4. Fuse shapes in place following manufacturer's instructions.
- 5. Appliqué edges of shapes by hand or machine.
- 6. Pin and sew four Fabric #1 and four Fabric #2, 2½" squares together as shown. Press seams toward the darker fabric. Make four combined square units.









SEWING DIRECTIONS Cont.

- 7. Pin and sew one combined unit to each side of pillow center following pillow diagram for orientation.
- Pin and sew one Fabric #1 and one Fabric #2, 2½" square to ends of one combined square unit as shown. Make two combined square units.



- Pin and sew to top and bottom of pillow center following pillow diagram for orientation.
- 10. Pin and sew Fabric #3, $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $20\frac{1}{2}$ " border rectangle to top and bottom of pillow center. Press seams toward border.
- 11. Pin and sew Fabric #3, $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ " border rectangle to sides of pillow center. Press seams toward border.

QUILTING AND FINISHING

- 1. Layer batting under pillow top.
- 2. Pin or baste layers together.
- 3. Model was machine quilted.
- 4. Trim batting edges even with pillow top.
- Fold and press under ½" on one 24½" edge of each Fabric #5, 18" x $24\frac{1}{2}$ " pillow back rectangles.
- 6. Fold and press under a second $\frac{1}{2}$ " to form a hemmed edge.
- 7. Top stitch hemmed edge with matching thread.
- 8. Lay quilted pillow top right side up on pinning surface.
- Position pillow back rectangles over pillow top (right sides together), overlapping rectangles to align with pillow top edges. Pin.
- 10. Sew 1/4" seam around edges of pillow.
- 11. Turn right sides out. Press.
- 12. Insert pillow form.
