# **FABRIC REQUIREMENTS**

- Fabric 1—¾ yard
- Fabric 2—¾ yard
- Fabric 3—% yard (includes binding)
- Fabric 4—1/3 yard
- Applique fabrics—Fabrics 2 through 4 and scraps or fat quarters

# FABRIC REQUIREMENTS Cont.

- Fusible web—1½ yards
- Backing-1 yard
- Batting—35" x 35"

# **CUTTING DIRECTIONS**

Apply fusible web to the wrong side of selected fabrics following manufacturer's instructions for appliqué shapes.

#### Fabric 1:

- Cut 1—6½" x 23½" rectangle across the width of fabric (WOF) for name panel
- Cut 1—5½" x 23½" rectangle across the WOF for "Room" panel
- Cut 2—3½" x 23½" rectangles across the WOF for appliqué panels

#### Fabric 2:

- Cut 1—6½" x 29½" rectangle across the WOF for bottom appliqué border
- Cut 2—3½" x 20½" rectangles across the WOF for side borders
- Cut 1—2½" x 29½" rectangle across the WOF for top border

#### Fabric 3:

- Cut 3—2½" strips across the WOF for binding
- Cut 1—1½" x 23½" rectangle across the WOF
- Cut 6—2½" squares

### Fabric 4:

• Cut 5—2½" squares

# Appliqué fabrics:

 Cut shapes (all with fusible web backing) from a variety of fabrics using the quilt diagram as inspiration. Cut letters for selected name. Use a leaf or scrap for apostrophe.

# **SEWING DIRECTIONS**

NOTE: Press seams toward the darker fabric or for the least bulk or as directed.

- Remove paper backing from appliqué shapes.
- Lay out shapes on each appliqué panel following
- 3. Fuse shapes in place following manufacturer's instructions.
- Appliqué edges of shapes by hand or machine.





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# **SEWING DIRECTIONS Cont.**

- Pin and sew six Fabric #3 and five Fabric #4, 21/2" squares together to form pieced row.
- Lay out appliqué panels, pieced row and Fabric #3,  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $23\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle following quilt diagram.
- 7. Pin and sew together to complete quilt center.
- Pin and sew one Fabric #2, 3½" x 20½" border rectangle to each side of quilt center. Press seams toward border.
- Pin and sew one Fabric #2, 2½" x 29½" border rectangle to top of quilt center. Press seams toward border.
- 10. Pin and sew one Fabric #2,  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $29\frac{1}{2}$ " appliquéd border rectangle to bottom of quilt center. Press seams toward border.

# **QUILTING AND FINISHING**

- Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
- 2. Pin or baste layers together.
- 3. Model was machine quilted.
- 4. Add binding, mitering corners.
