



GO!® Dies Used, Number of Shapes to Cut & Fabric Requirements



Fabric Color	GO! Dies Used	Number of Shapes to Cut	Fabric Required
Cream	GO! Orange Peel-4½" (55455)	Cut 15—5" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. (Apply fusible web to the wrong side prior to cutting following the manufacturer's instructions). Fanfold into 5" widths. Cut 120 orange peels.	2 1/3 yards
Dark Blue	GO! Square-5" (4½" Finished) (55010)	Cut 2—10½" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 5½" widths. Cut 20 5" squares.	3/4 yard
Dark Medium Blue	GO! Square-5" (4½" Finished) (55010)	Cut 2—10½" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 5½" widths. Cut 20 5" squares.	3/4 yard
Medium Blue	GO! Square-5" (4½" Finished) (55010)	Cut 2—10½" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 5½" widths. Cut 20 5" squares.	3/4 yard
Green	GO! Square-5" (4½" Finished) (55010)	Cut 5—10½" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 5½" widths. Cut 60 5" squares.	1 3/4 yards

Additional Fabrics Needed

- Fusible Web Product—4½ yards
- Border—1/2 yard – Cut 6—1½" x WOF strips using GO! Strip Cutter-1½" (1" Finished) (55024)
- Binding—3/4 yard – Cut 7—2½" x WOF strips using GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55014 or 55017)
- Backing—3½ yards
- Batting—57" x 66"

Sewing Directions

1. Fold and press dark blue, dark medium blue, medium blue and green 5" squares in half diagonally as shown for positioning.
2. Center and fuse 60 cream Orange Peels to 20 dark blue, 20 dark medium blue, and 20 medium blue 5" squares leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance from edges.
3. Center and fuse 60 cream Orange Peels to 60 green 5" squares leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance from edges.
4. Using a decorative stitch on your machine, stitch around the edges of the appliquéd shapes to secure them to the block.
5. Lay out 20 dark blue, 20 dark medium blue, 20 medium blue, and 60 green appliquéd squares alternating directions as shown.
6. Sew blocks together into rows pressing seams in opposite directions.
7. Sew rows together pressing seams in the same direction.
8. Sew together the 6-1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips along the short side.
9. Measure the length of the quilt in the center. Cut two borders to this length.
10. Pin and sew the borders onto the left and right sides of the quilt. Pressing towards the borders.
11. Measure the width of the quilt in the center. Cut two borders to this length.
12. Pin and sew the borders onto the top and bottom of the quilt.

Quilting & Finishing

1. Layer quilt top with batting and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Model was custom machine quilted.
4. Attach bias binding, mitering the corners.
