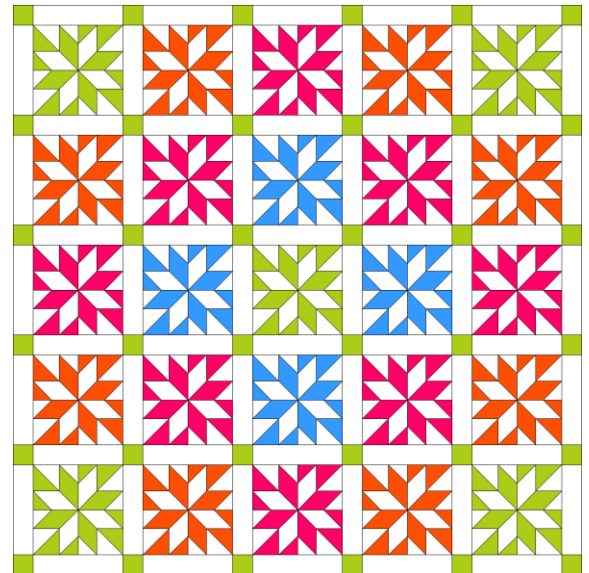

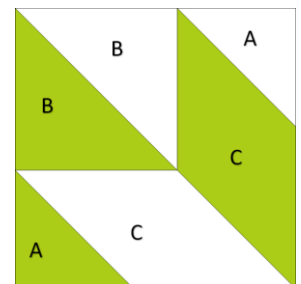
### GO!® Dies Used, Number of Shapes to Cut & Fabric Requirements



Fabric Color	GO! Dies Used	Number of Shapes to Cut	Fabric Required
<b>Note:</b> Cut 7¾" x 6¾" rectangles for LeMoyne Star die. Layer two layers of the same color <b>right sides up</b> and two layers of a second color <b>wrong sides up</b> on the blades and cut.			
White	GO! LeMoyne Star-9" Finished (55453)	Cut 50—7¾" x 6¾" rectangles. Layer right sides up. Sub cut into 100 Diamonds (Shape C), 100 Triangle A & 100 Triangle B.	3½ yards
White	GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55014 or 55017)	Cut 15—2½" x WOF strips. Sub cut into 60—2½" x 9½" Sashing Strips.	Yardage included above
Green	GO! LeMoyne Star-9" Finished (55453)	Cut 10—7¾" x 6¾" rectangles. Layer wrong sides up. Sub cut into 20 Diamonds (C), 20 Triangle A & 20 Triangle B.	1 yard
Green	GO! Square-2½" (2" Finished) Multiples (55059)	Cut 1—8" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 8" widths. Sub cut into 36—2½" x 2½" Cornerstones.	Yardage included above
Blue	GO! LeMoyne Star-9" Finished (55453)	Cut 8—7¾" x 6¾" rectangles. Layer wrong sides up. Sub cut into 16 Diamonds (C), 16 Triangle A & 16 Triangle B.	2/3 yard
Pink	GO! LeMoyne Star-9" Finished (55453)	Cut 16—7¾" x 6¾" rectangles. Layer wrong sides up. Sub cut into 32 Diamonds (C), 32 Triangle A & 32 Triangle B.	1 yard
Orange	GO! LeMoyne Star-9" Finished (55453)	Cut 16—7¾" x 6¾" rectangles. Layer wrongs sides up. Sub cut into 32 Diamonds (C), 32 Triangle A & 32 Triangle B.	1 yard

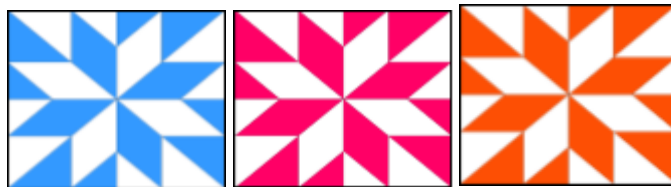
### Additional Fabrics Needed

- Binding—¾ yard – Cut 7—2½" x WOF strips using GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55014 or 55017)
- Backing—¾ yards
- Batting—67" x 67"



## Sewing Directions

1. Lay out one white diamond (Shape C), one green triangle (Shape A) and one green triangle (Shape B) as shown.
2. Sew pieces together, following directions listed at right, pressing towards dark.
3. Lay out one green diamond (Shape C), one white triangle (Shape A) and one white triangle (Shape B) as shown.
4. Sew pieces together, pressing towards dark.
5. Sew Unit #1 and Unit #2 together along the long edge to create Unit #1. Press seams open. Block should measure 5" x 5".
6. Repeat to make four Unit #1 Blocks.
7. Lay out four Unit #1 Blocks as shown in Unit #2. Sewing into rows and then sewing rows together pressing seams open.
8. Block #1 should measure 9½" x 9½".
9. Repeat above steps to make a total of five Block #1, four Block #2, eight Block #3 and eight Block #4.

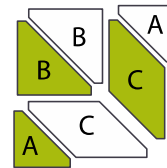

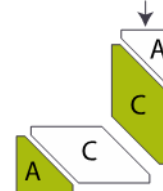

10. Lay out five Block #1, four Block #2, eight Block #3, eight Block #4, 60–Sashing Strips and 36–Cornerstones as shown on page 3.
11. Pin and sew into rows, pressing seams in opposite directions.
12. Pin and sew rows together. Press seams in the same direction.



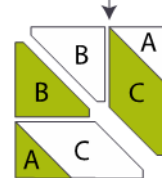

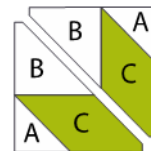
**How to Sew LeMoyne Star Units**  
Step 1: Lay out cut pieces with the dog-eared corners facing as shown.

Step 2: Match up dog-eared corners, then sew Triangle A to Diamond C.

Sew B onto A/C, start sewing on outside



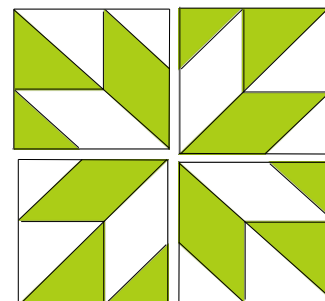
Step 3: Align Triangle B to edge of A/C unit as shown. Start sewing from outside edge to make A/B/C unit.



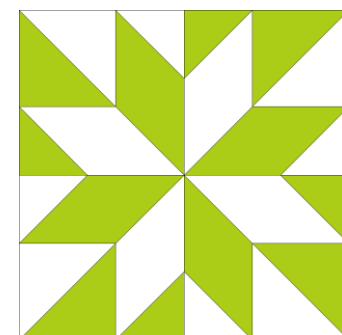
Step 4: Sew A/B/C units together to make quarter units.

## Quilting & Finishing

1. Layer quilt top with batting and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Model was custom machine quilted.
4. Attach binding, mitering the corners.
