

### Additional Fabrics Needed:

- Backing—54" x 54"
- Batting—54" x 54"
- Fusible Web—1¼ Yard



## Sewing Directions:

1. Lay out, fuse and appliqué owl pieces, branches and leaves on each of the sixteen white 6½" squares using the wall hanging diagram below as a guide.





2. Using the wall hanging diagram for color placement, pin and sew a 1½" x 6½" strip to both the left and right side of the appliquéd block. Press seams toward the fabric strips.
3. Repeat for remaining 15 blocks.
4. Using the wall hanging diagram for color placement, pin and sew a 1½" x 8½" strip to both the top and bottom of the appliquéd block. Press seams toward the fabric strips.
5. Repeat for remaining 15 blocks.
6. Using the wall hanging diagram for color placement, pin and sew a 2½" x 8½" strip to both the left and right side of the appliquéd block. Press seams toward the fabric strips.
7. Repeat for remaining 15 blocks.
8. Using the wall hanging diagram for color placement, pin and sew a 2½" x 12½" strip to both the top and bottom of the appliquéd block. Press seams toward the fabric strips.
9. Repeat for remaining 15 blocks.
10. Lay out the blocks in four rows of four, using the wall hanging diagram as a guide.
11. Pin and sew four rows. Press seams in alternating directions for each row.
12. Pin and sew four row units together. Press seams towards the added rows.



## Quilting & Finishing:

1. Layer batting between wall hanging top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add orange binding, mitering corners.
