## Additional Fabrics Needed:

- White Fabric-241/2" x 241/2" (yardage included above)
- Backing-36" x 36"
- Batting-36" x 36"
- Fusible Web-1 Yard


## Sewing Directions:

1. Lay out, fuse, and appliqué the stem, heart, and owl shapes to the white $241 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 241 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square, as shown in the block diagram (right).
2. Pin and sew a green $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 241 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strip on either side of the appliqué block. Press seams toward the border strips.
3. Pin and sew one green $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 261 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strip on the top and one on the bottom of the appliqué block. Press seams toward the border strips.
4. Lay out, pin and sew $13-2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ (2" finished) squares as shown to form a side border unit. Make two side border units.

## Side Border Unit - Make Two:

5. Pin and sew side border unit on either side of the appliqué block unit, as shown. Press seams toward the border units.

6. Lay out, pin and sew $14-2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ (2" finished) squares as shown to form a border unit. Make two border units.

## Border Unit - Make Two:

7. Pin and sew one border unit on the top and one on the bottom of the appliqué block unit, as shown. Press seams toward the border strips.

## Quilting \& Finishing:



1. Layer batting between wall hanging top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add red binding, mitering corners.
