

## Fabric Requirements:

Featuring the "Lemony Squeeze" fabric line from Benartex.
Yardages are for die-cutting the project, you will need a little less for traditional cutting.
This quilt is made using a (36) piece layer cake of 10 " squares plus white fabric.

## You will also need:

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- $23 / 4$ yards of fabric for the backing
-47" x 47" piece of batting
- GO! Ohio Star-12" Finished (55174)
- Basic Sewing Supplies \& Tools

You will need the following:
-(14) Assorted Pink 10" squares (A)

- (9) Assorted Yellow \& Light Green 10" squares (B)
- (4) Assorted Green 10 " squares (C)
- (9) Assorted White Print 10 " squares (D)
- Solid White (E) $1^{11 / 3}$ yards
- Binding (F) $1 / 3$ yard

Please read all instructions before starting. Measurement on borders are approximate. Measure your quilt top before cutting.
Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance unless otherwise noted. Width of Fabric = WOF, Length of Fabric = LOF
Note: Below we have provided both die-cutting and traditional cutting instructions. You only need to use one set of cutting instructions in order to complete the project. The chosen method is up to you.

## Die Cutting Instructions:

Fabric A - Assorted Pinks, cut (1) square from each 10" square for the following:

- Cut (10) 6" squares. Use the GO! Ohio Star-12" Finished die to die-cut (40) triangles.
- Cut (4) $51 / 2 \prime$ " squares. Use the GO! Ohio Star-12" Finished die to die-cut (4) squares.
- Cut (7) $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ strips from remaining fabric.

Fabric B - Assorted Yellows \& Light Greens, cut (1) square from each 10" square for the following:

- Cut (8) 6 " squares. Use the GO! Ohio Star-12" Finished die to die-cut (32) triangles.
- Cut (1) $51 / 2$ " square. Use the GO! Ohio Star-12" Finished die to die-cut (1) square.
- Cut (7) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ strips from remaining fabric.

Fabric C - Assorted Greens, cut (1) square from each 10" square for the following:

- Cut (4) 6 " squares. Use the GO! Ohio Star-12" Finished die to die-cut (16) triangles.
- Cut (4) $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ strips from remaining fabric.

Fabric D-Assorted White Prints, cut (1) square from each 10" square for the following:

- Cut (5) $6^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Use the GO! Ohio Star-12" Finished die to die-cut (20) triangles.
- Cut (4) 5 ½" squares. Use the GO! Ohio Star-12" Finished die to die-cut (4) squares.
- Cut (4) matching $2^{\prime \prime}$ squares from remaining fabric.


## Fabric E-Solid White

- Cut (9) 6" squares. Use the GO! Ohio Star-12" Finished die to die-cut (36) triangles.
- Cut (36) $5 ½ \prime$ " squares. Use the GO! Ohio Star-12" Finished die to die-cut (36) squares.


## Fabric F (Binding)

- Cut (4) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} x$ WOF strips for the binding.


## Backing (Your Choice)

- Cut (2) 47 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 47 " $\times 47$ " back.



## Traditional Cutting Instructions:

Fabric A - Assorted Pinks, cut (1) square from each 10" square for the following:

- Cut (10) $51 / 4$ " squares. Cut each square across both diagonals to make (40) triangles.
- Cut (4) $41 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
- Cut (7) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ strips from remaining fabric.

Fabric B - Assorted Yellows \& Light Greens, cut (1) square from each 10" square for the following:

- Cut (8) $5 \frac{114}{1 / 4}$ squares. Cut each square across both diagonals to make (32) triangles.
- Cut (3) $41 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
- Cut (7) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ strips from remaining fabric.


## Fabric C - Assorted Greens, cut (1) square from each 10" square for the following:

- Cut (4) $51 / 4 "$ squares. Cut each square across both diagonals to make (16) triangles.
- Cut (4) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ strips from remaining fabric.

Fabric D - Assorted White Prints, cut (1) square from each 10" square for the following:

- Cut (4) $51 / 4 "$ squares. Cut each square across both diagonals to make (16) triangles.
- Cut (2) $411 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
- Cut (4) matching 2 " squares from remaining fabric.


## Fabric E-Solid White

- Cut (9) $51 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Cut each square across both diagonals to make (36) triangles.
- Cut (36) $411 / 2 "$ squares


## Fabric F (Binding)

- Cut (4) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for the binding.


## Backing (Your Choice)

-Cut (2) 47 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 47 " x 47" back.


## Assembly Instructions:

1. Sew together (2) Fabric A triangles, (1) Fabric C triangle and (1) Fabric E triangle to make (1) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (16) $41 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ Unit 1 squares total.
2. Refer to Figure 2 to sew together (4) $41 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E squares, (1) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D square and (4) $41 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ Unit 1 squares to make (1) 12 ½" Block One square. Repeat to make (4) Block One squares total.

3. Sew together (2) Fabric B triangles, (1) Fabric D triangle and (1) Fabric E triangle to make (1) $41 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ Unit 2 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (16) $41 ⁄ 22^{\prime \prime}$ Unit 2 squares total.
4. Refer to Figure 4 to sew together (4) $41 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E squares, (1) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A square and (4) $41 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ Unit 2 squares to make (1) 12 ½" Block Two square. Repeat to make (4) Block Two squares total.

5. Sew together (2) Fabric A triangles, (1) Fabric D triangle and (1) Fabric E triangle to make (1) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Unit 3 square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (4) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Unit 3 squares total.
6. Refer to Figure 6 to sew together (4) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E squares, (1) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $B$ square and (4) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Unit 3 squares to make (1) $121 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ Block Three square.

7. Follow Figure 7 for fabric placement to sew together (7) $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A strips, (7) $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strips and (4) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C strips lengthwise to make (1) strip set.

8. Cut (4) $2^{2 \prime}$ segments from the strip set to make (4) borders (Fig. 8). Two of these will be the side borders.

9. Sew (1) $2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D square to each end of two borders to make the top and bottom borders (Fig. 9).

## Quilt Top Assembly Instructions: Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.

10. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row.
11. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) Block Three square to make the middle row.
12. Sew the three rows together to make the quilt top.
13. Sew (1) side border to each side of the quilt top. Sew the top and bottom borders to the quilt top.
14. Layer and quilt as desired.
15. Sew the (4) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric $F$ binding strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
