## GO! Posy Patch Quilt

## Finished Size: 20" x 20"



Dies Needed:

- GO! Circle - ½", 3/4", 1", 114" (55484)
- GO! Stems \& Leaves (55331)
- GO! Qube ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ Mix \& Match 8" Block (55776)
o GO! Square-4½" (4" Finished) (Shape 1)
- GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)


## Cutting Directions:

*NOTE: Apply fusible web to the wrong side of asterisked fabrics following manufacturer's instructions before cutting appliqué shapes.

| *Red <br> Wool | $\begin{aligned} & \text { GO! Circle-1/2", 3/4", 1", } \\ & \text { 114" (55484) } \end{aligned}$ | Cut $2-21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Sub cut into $16-1 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime}$ circles. | Fat eighth or large scrap |
| *Red <br> Wool | $\begin{aligned} & \text { GO! Circle-1/2", 3/4", 1", } \\ & \text { 114" (55484) } \end{aligned}$ | Cut 1—2" x 2" square. Sub cut into 4-1" circles. | Yardage included above |
| *Orange Wool | $\begin{aligned} & \text { GO! Circle-1/2", 3/4", 1", } \\ & \text { 1¼" (55484) } \end{aligned}$ | Cut $1-2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Sub cut into 8—11/4" circles. | Fat eighth or large scrap |
| *Orange <br> Wool | $\begin{aligned} & \text { GO! Circle-1/2", 3/4", 1", } \\ & 11 / 4 "(55484) \end{aligned}$ | Cut $1-2$ " x 3 3/4" rectangle. Sub cut into 8-1" circles. | Yardage included above |
| *Yellow Wool | $\begin{aligned} & \text { GO! Circle-1/2", 3/4", 1", } \\ & 111 / 4 "(55484) \end{aligned}$ | Cut $1-1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3$ " rectangle. Sub cut into $8 — 3 / 4$ " circles. Cut $1 — 1 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Sub cut into $4 — 3 / 4$ " circles for a total of $12 — 3 / 4$ " circles. | Fat eighth or large scrap |
| *Yellow Wool | $\begin{aligned} & \text { GO! Circle-1/2", 3/4", 1", } \\ & 11 / 4 "(55484) \end{aligned}$ | Cut $1-1 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ " rectangle. Sub cut into $8-1 / 2$ " circles. Cut $1 — 1 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime}$ square. Sub cut into $4 — 1 / 2$ " circles for a total of $12 — 3 / 4$ " circles. | Yardage included above |
| *Green Wool | GO! Stems \& Leaves (55331) | Cut 16—2" $\times 3 / 4$ " leaves | Fat eighth or large scrap |
| *Green Cotton | GO! Stems \& Leaves (55331) | Cut 64—2" x 3/4" leaves | 1/2 yard |
| *Green Cotton | GO! Stems \& Leaves (55331) | Cut $4-7{ }^{11} / 16^{\prime \prime} \times 13 / 16^{\prime \prime}$ stems | Yardage included above |
| Black <br> Cotton | $1 \quad \text { (55776) }$ | Cut 1—5" $x$ width of fabric (WOF) strip. Fanfold into 5" widths. Sub cut into 8—4" finished squares. | 1/2 yard |
| White Cotton | $1 \text { (55776) }$ | Cut 1—5" $\times$ width of fabric (WOF) strip. Fanfold into 5" widths. Sub cut into 8—4" finished squares. | 1/4 yard |
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Additional Yardage and Cutting Instructions:

- Red Cotton-1/4 yard
o Use GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014) to cut 2—2½" x WOF strips. Sub cut into $2 — 2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 16^{1 / 2 "}$ strips and $2 — 2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 201 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips for borders.
o Use GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014) to cut $2 — 2^{1 ⁄ 21}$ " x WOF strips for binding.
- Black Cotton-yardage included above
o Use GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014) to cut 3—2½" x WOF strips for binding.


## Additional Fabrics Needed:

- Fusible Web: 1/2 yard
- Batting: 26" x 26"
- Backing: 26" x 26 "


## Sewing Directions:

Press all seams open and use $1 / 4$ " seams, unless otherwise indicated.

1. Lay out, center, fuse and/or fabric glue and appliqué 4-green cotton leaves, 1—red wool 11/4" circle, 1—orange wool 1" circle and 1—yellow $3 / 4$ " circle on one black 4" finished square (Shape 1) as shown. Make sure not to cover the $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Make 8 blocks.
2. Lay out, center, fuse and/or fabric glue and appliqué 4-green cotton leaves, 1 -red wool $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " circle and 1 -yellow wool $1 / 2$ " circle on one white 4" finished square (Shape 1) as shown. Make sure not to cover
 the $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Make 8 blocks.
3. Lay out, pin and sew the 16 blocks in four rows of four. Alternate blocks for each row as shown. Press seams toward the black 4" finished square in each row. Pin and sew rows together to create quilt top. Press seams toward the added rows.
4. Lay out, center, fuse and/or fabric glue and appliqué 1green cotton stem, 4-green wool leaves, 2-orange wool $11 / 4$ " circles, $1 —$ red wool 1" circle, 1-yellow wool

$3 / 4$ " circle and $1 — y e l l o w$ wool 112 " circle on $1 —$ red cotton $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 161 / 2$ " strip as shown. Make two strip units.

5. Lay out, center, fuse and/or fabric glue and appliqué 1—green cotton stem, 4-green wool leaves, 2—orange wool $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " circles, 1—red wool 1" circle, 1—yellow wool $3 / 4$ " circle and $1 —$ yellow wool $1 / 2$ " circle on 1 -red cotton $2^{1 ⁄ 2 " ~} \times 201 / 2$ " strip as shown. Make two strip units.

6. Pin and sew $1-2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 16^{1 / 2 "}$ strip unit to each side of the quilt top.
7. Pin and sew $1-2^{1 / 2 "} \times 201 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip unit on the top and bottom of the quilt top.

## Quilting and Finishing



1. Layer batting between table topper and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add black binding, mitering corners.

## Finishing Options

This design could also be finished as a 20" pillow or wall hanging.
