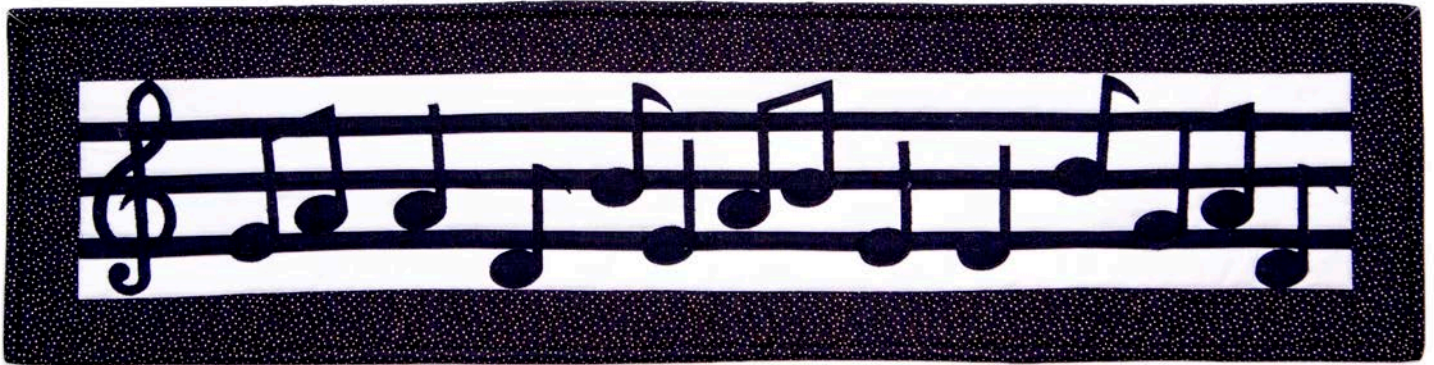


## GO! Looking for Treble Table Runner

Finished Size: 9" x 36"



### Dies Needed:

- GO! Music Medley (55482)
- GO! Strip Cutter-1", 1½", 2" (½", 1", 1½" Finished) (55164)
- GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)

### Cutting Directions:

*\*NOTE: Apply fusible web to the wrong side of asterisked fabrics following manufacturer's instructions before cutting appliqué shapes.*

Fabric Color	Shape & Number	Number of Shapes to Cut	Total Fabric Required
Black	GO! Strip Cutter-1", 1½", 2" (½", 1", 1½" Finished) (55164)	Cut 3—½" finished strips.	1/2 yard
*Black	GO! Music Medley (55482)	Cut 1—treble clef; cut 3—single bar notes; cut 4—quarter notes; cut 4—eighth notes	Yardage included above
White	GO! Strip Cutter-1", 1½", 2" (½", 1", 1½" Finished) (55164)	Cut 4—1" finished strips.	1/4 yard
Black Dot	GO! Strip Cutter-1", 1½", 2" (½", 1", 1½" Finished) (55164)	Cut 4—1½" finished strips.	1/2 yard

### Additional Yardage and Cutting Instructions:

- Black Dot—Yardage included above
  - Use GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014) to cut 3—2½" x WOF strips for binding.

### Additional Fabrics Needed:

- Fusible Web: ½ yard
- Batting: 12" x 40"
- Backing: 12" x 40"

### Sewing Directions:

*Press all seams open and use ¼" seams, unless otherwise indicated.*

1. Pin and sew 3—black ½" finished and 4—white 1" finished strip together starting with the cram strip as shown. Press seams toward the black solid. Make 1 strip set.
2. Trim strip set to measure 5½" x 32½".

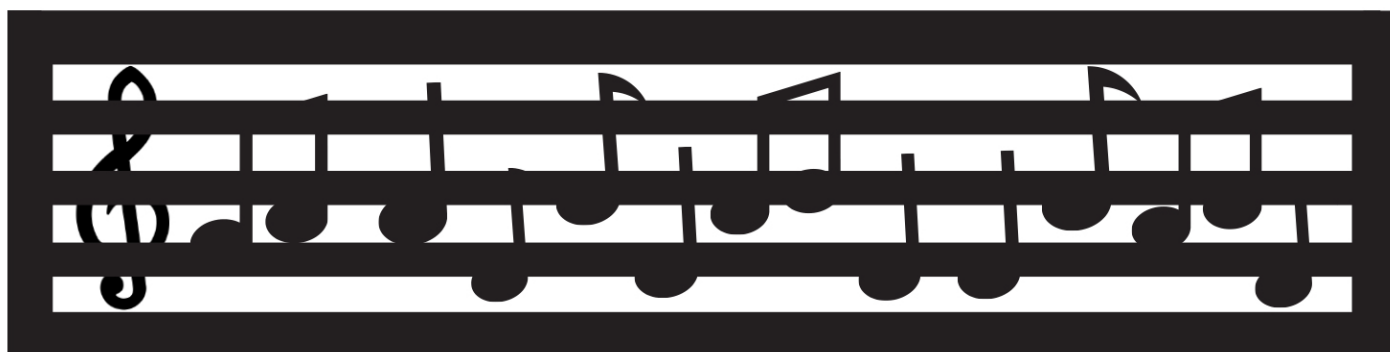


### Assemble Borders

1. Sub cut the 1½" finished borders into 2—2" x 32½" borders for the top and bottom and 2—2" x 9" borders for the sides.
2. Stitch the border to the sides of the quilt first. Pin carefully, easing top as needed to fit the border.
3. Stitch the border to the top and bottom of the quilt. Pin carefully, easing top as needed to fit the border.
4. Press seam allowances toward the border.

## Music Medley Appliqué

Place the appliqué pieces as shown: 1—treble clef, 3—single bar notes, 4—quarter notes, 4—eighth notes or arrange the notes on the lines or spaces as desired. Appliqué edges as desired. ## Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between table runner and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add black dot binding, mitering corners.
