## GO!® Dies Used, Number of Shapes to Cut & Fabric Requirements

Fabric Color	Shape	GO! Dies Used	Number of Shapes to Cut	Fabric Required
Cream		GO! Crossed Canoes- 9" Finished (55181)	Cut 4—6¼" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Fanfold into 6¼" widths. Sub cut into 16—sets of side sections.	3/4 yard
Raspberry		GO! Crossed Canoes- 9" Finished (55181)	Cut 2—6¼" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 6¼" widths. Sub cut into 8—center sections (HST & narrow triangle).	3/8 yard
Pink		GO! Crossed Canoes- 9" Finished (55181)	Cut 2—6¼" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 6¼" widths. Sub cut into 8—center sections (HST & narrow triangle).	3/8 yard
Sherbet		GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55014 or 55017)	Cut 2—2½" x WOF strips for borders.	1/2 yard


Tip: Use the extra cut shapes for another quilt project

#### Additional Fabrics Needed:

- Backing—24" x 24"
- Batting—24" x 24"

#### **Sewing Directions:**

- 1. Lay out, pin and sew one pink half square triangle (HST) to the top of the raspberry center section as shown. Press seam toward the pink HST. Make eight units.
- 2. Lay out, pin and sew one raspberry HST to the top of the pink center section as shown. Press seam toward the pink. Make eight units.
- 3. Lay out, pin and sew one cream side section to each center section as shown. Press seam toward the cream. Make eight raspberry units and eight pink units.



4. Lay out, pin and sew two units together as shown. Make eight half block units. Press seams open.




5. Lay out, pin and sew two half block units together as shown. Make four blocks. Press seams open.







6. Lay out, pin and sew the four blocks together as shown. Press seams open.



#### **Border:**

- 1. Lay out, pin and sew one 21/2" x 181/2" sherbet batik border to the two sides of the wall hanging. Press toward the border.
- 2. Lay out, pin and sew one 21/2" x 221/2" sherbet batik border to the top and bottom of the wall hanging. Press toward the border.





### **Quilting and Finishing:**

- 1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
- 2. Pin or baste layers together.
- 3. Quilt as desired.
- 4. Add sherbet binding, mitering corners.
