- GO! Strip Cutter-2-1/4" (1-3/4" Finished) (55053)


## Fabric Requirements:

## Cutting Directions:

| Fabric Color | Die | Number of Shapes to Cut |

| Orange | GO! Bear's <br> Paw-14" <br> Finished <br> (55461) | Cut 2—5" $x$ width of fabric (WOF) strips. Sub cut 12—4 1/2" squares. |
| Light Green | GO! Bear's <br> Paw-14" <br> Finished <br> (55461) | Cut 2—3 3/4" x WOF strips. Sub cut into 48-2" finished half square triangles. |
| Dark Green | GO! Bear's <br> Paw-14" <br> Finished <br> (55461) | Cut 1-3" $\times$ WOF strips. Sub cut into 5-2 1/2" squares. |
| Dark Green | GO! Strip <br> Cutter-2-1/4" (1- <br> 3/4" Finished) <br> (55053) | Cut enough $2 \frac{1}{4}$ " strips, WOF or Bias to make 160" of binding. |
| Yellow | GO! Bear's Paw-14" <br> Finished (55461) | Cut 1-11" x WOF strip. Simultaneously sub cut 48-2" Finished HSTs, $12-21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, and $12-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. |
| Yellow | GO! Bear's Paw-14" <br> Finished (55461) | Cut $1-3$ " x WOF strip or use leftover. Sub cut 4 more-2 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles |
| Yellow | $\begin{aligned} & \text { GO! Strip } \\ & \text { Cutter-2-1/2" (2" } \\ & \text { Finished) } \\ & (55017) \end{aligned}$ | Cut 4-2 112" $\times$ WOF strips. |

## Sewing Directions:

Press all seams open and use $1 / 4$ " seams, unless otherwise indicated.

## BEAR'S CLAW UNIT

NOTE: Directions will be for one 14" finished block. Make 3 blocks.

1. Lay out 1 orange square, 4 light green triangles, 4 yellow triangles, and 1 yellow square as one of the Bear's Claw units.
2. Sew a light green triangle with a yellow triangle together to complete a halfl-square triangle unit that measures 2 $1 / 2 "$ square. Make 4 of these and replace your layout.

3. Sew the adjacent half-square triangle units together. (Note: The pair of half-square triangle units on one side is a mirror image of the pair on the other side.)

4. Continue to sew units together until completed. It should measure $61 / 2 "$ square. Most 3 more Bear's Claw units.
5. Lay out the 4 Bear's Claw units, 4 yellow rectangles and 1 dark green small square. Make sure the Bear's Claw units are rotated correctly. Sew the units within each row together and then sew the rows together to complete the block. It should measure $141 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.

6. Repeat steps to make 2 more blocks.
7. For sashing, sew a yellow rectangle on opposite sides of a dark green square. Make two of these.

8. Lay out the 3 blocks with sashing between the blocks. Sew together to form the quilt center. It should measure $141 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 461 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


## Border

1. From one of the yellow border strips, cut $2-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18$ $1 / 2$ " short side borders.
2. Sew the 3 remaining border strips together to make one long strip. From this, cut $2-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 461 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ long side borders.
3. Sew a long side border on both long sides of the quilt center.
4. Sew the short side borders onto the short sides to complete the quilt. It should measure $181 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 501 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


## Assemble the Quilt Top

1. Lay out blocks in 1 rows of 3 blocks each as shown in quilt diagram. Sew blocks together into rows. Press seams to one side.
2. Sew rows together. Press seams in opposite directions

## Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
