## Fabric Requirements:

| Fabric C (Red) | $1-1 / 2$ yards |
| Batting | $54 " \times 54 "$ |
| Backing | $54 " \times 54 "$ |

## Cutting Directions:

Cut four blocks $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 22^{\prime \prime}$,

Fabric A (Black)

Rotary Cutter
Cut four right triangles $10^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ (the third side will be approximately 14-1/4")

Cut four Triangles 14 " $\times 14^{\prime \prime}$ (the third side will be approximately 20")

Cut 2-4 $1 / 2$ " $\times 461 / 4$ " strips
Cut 2—4 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 541 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ strips
better cuts make - better quilis'

Press all seams open and use $1 / 4$ " seams, unless otherwise indicated.

## Bear's Paw Block Assembly

## Unit 1

1. Sew one triangle of Fabric $A$ to one triangle of Fabric $C$ to make a half-square triangle (HST).

2. Sew together two HSTs.


## Unit 2

3. Sew one triangle of Fabric C to one triangle of Fabric A to make an HST.

4. Sew together two HSTs.

## Unit 3


5. Sew Unit 1 to the small square, as shown.


## Unit 4

6. Sew Unit 2 to the large square, as shown.


Unit 5
7. Sew Unit 3 to Unit 4. You will need to make 16 Unit 5 blocks.


## Unit 6

8. Combine 4—Unit 5 blocks with 4—rectangles and 1small square, as shown. You will make 4—Unit 6 blocks. Trim to $141 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


Center Block Assembly

1. Sew together your center block using $4-6 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares, $1-21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square, and $4-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} \times 7^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H}$ rectangle. Trim to $141 / 2$ ".


## Assemble the Quilt Top

1. Lay out blocks as shown in quilt diagram. Sew blocks together into rows. Press seams to one side.
2. Sew rows together. Press seams in opposite directions

## Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
