## GO! Cleopatra's Garden Gate Quilt

Finished Size: 30" x 30"


## Dies Needed:

- GO! Cleopatra's Fan-12" Finished (55490)
- GO! Strip Cutter-2-1/2" (2" Finished) 3 Strips (55017 or 55014)
- GO! Strip Cutter-1-1/2" (1" Finished) 5 Strips (55024)

Fabric Requirements:

| Fabric Color | Total Yardage |
| :--- | :---: |
| Dark Purple | 1 yard |
| Purple Dots, Pink <br> and Dark Blue | $3 / 4$ yard each |
| Maroon and Light <br> Blue | $1 / 2$ yard each |
| Batting | $40 " \times 40^{\prime \prime}$ |
| Backing | $11 / 8$ yard or $40 " 40 "$ |
| Binding | $1 / 3$ yard |

## Cutting Directions:

## Sewing Directions:

Press all seams open and use $11 / 4$ " seams, unless otherwise indicated.

## Cleopatra's Garden Gate Block

NOTE: Directions will be for one 12" finished block. Make 4 blocks.

1. Sew one dark purple piece $A$ and one maroon piece $B$ together for the left side of the block and one dark purple piece $A$ and one pink piece $B$ together for the right side of the block as shown. Press the seam, for the left side
 of the block, toward B and toward A for the right side of the block.
2. Sew one purple dots piece $C$ and one purple dots piece D together for the left and right sides of the block as shown. Press the seam, for the left side of the block, toward $C$ and toward $D$ for the right side of the block.

3. Sew one purple dots piece $E$ to the C/D purple dots units made in \#2 above for the left and right sides of the block as shown. Press the seam, for the left side of the block, toward C/D and toward E for the right side of the block.

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4. Sew one dark purple piece $F$ and one dark blue piece $G$ together for the left side of the block and one dark purple piece $F$ and one light blue piece $G$ together for the right side of the block as shown. Press the seam, for the left side of the block, toward F and toward $G$ for the right side of the block.

5. Sew one pink piece H to the $\mathrm{F} / \mathrm{G}$ units made in \#4 above for the left, and right, sides of the block as shown. Press the seam for both sides of the block toward H .

6. Sew one dark purple piece I to the $F / G / H$ units made in \#5 above for the left, and right, sides of the block as shown. Press the seam for the left side of the block toward I and toward F/G/H for the right side of the block.

7. Sew one maroon piece J to the $\mathrm{F} / \mathrm{G} / \mathrm{H} / \mathrm{l}$ unit made in \#6 above for the left, and a pink piece J to a $\mathrm{F} / \mathrm{G} / \mathrm{H} / \mathrm{l}$ unit for the right side of the block as shown. Press the seam for the left side of the block toward J and toward $\mathrm{F} / \mathrm{G} / \mathrm{H} / \mathrm{I}$ for the right side of the block.

8. Sew a left unit $A / B$ from \#1 above to a left unit C/D/E from \#3 above. Repeat for the right side. Press toward the units $\mathrm{A} / \mathrm{B}$.

9. Sew a left unit $A / B / C / D / E$ from \#8 above to a left unit F/G/H///J from \#7 above. Repeat for the right side. Press toward the units $A / B / C / D / E$.

10. Sew the half block units made in \#9 above together to make a completed 12.5 " unfinished block. Make 3 more blocks.


## Assemble the Quilt Top

11. Lay out four blocks per the diagram to the right. Sew the top row together and press to the right. Sew the bottom row together and press to the left.
12. Sew the top and bottom rows together. Press toward the top row. The center of your quilt top is complete.
13. Sew a $1.5 " \times 24.5^{\prime \prime}$ light blue inner border to the left and right sides of the quilt top. (TIP: Measure the side of your quilt top first and if it does not measure 24.5", you may want to sew the inner border on first and then trim to fit quilt top.) Next add the $1.5 " \times 26.5$ " top and bottom inner border.

14. Sew a $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 26-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ dark purple outer border to the left and right sides of the quilt top. (TIP: Again, measure the side of your quilt top first and if it does not measure 26-1/2", you may want to sew the outer border on first and then trim to fit quilt top.) Next add the 2-1/2" x 301/2" top and bottom outer border.


## Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
