- GO! Bear's Paw-14" Finished (55461)
- GO! Strip Cutter-2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55014 or 55017)


Fabric Requirements

| Fabric Color | Total Yardage |
| :--- | :---: |
| White on White (Silver) | $1 / 2$ yard |
| Red Fabric (includes border and binding) | $2-1 / 4$ yards |
| Batting | $28^{\prime \prime} \times 52^{\prime \prime}$ |
| Backing | $28^{\prime \prime} \times 52^{\prime \prime}$ |

## Sewing Directions

Press all seams open and use 1/4" seams, unless otherwise indicated.

## Bear's Paw Block

NOTE: Directions will be for one 8 " finished block. Make 10 blocks.

1. Sew one white and one red 2 " finished half square triangle (HST) (Shape B) together as shown. Press seams open. Make 40 HST units.
2. Sew HST units together as shown. Make 10 right oriented units and 10 left oriented units.

3. Lay out, pin and sew a white 2" finished square (Shape C) to a right oriented triangle unit as shown. Make 10.

4. Lay out, pin and sew a left oriented HST unit to a red 4" finished square (Shape A) as shown. Make 10 square/triangle units.

5. Lay out, pin and sew a right oriented HST/square unit to the red square/triangle unit as shown. Make 10 bear's paw units.

6. Lay out, pin and sew one white 2 " x 6" finished rectangle (Shape D) to one red 2" finished square (Shape C). Make 10.
7. Lay out, pin and sew one white 2 " $\times 6$ " finished rectangle (Shape D) to the HST/red square unit as shown. Make 10.

8. Lay out, pin and sew the white rectangle/red square unit to the white rectangle/bear's paw unit. Make 10 finished blocks.


## Assemble the Quilt Top

1. Lay out blocks in 5 rows of 2 blocks each as shown in quilt diagram. Rotate blocks as shown in the diagram and sew blocks together into rows. Press seams to one side.
2. Sew rows together. Press seams in opposite directions

## Assemble the Border

1. Cut the vertical and horizontal borders according to the cutting instructions. Measure the height of the table runner and adjust the length of the vertical border accordingly. Stitch the vertical border to the sides of the quilt.
2. Measure the width of the quilt including the vertical borders and adjust the length of the horizontal borders accordingly. Stitch the horizontal border to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press seam allowances toward the borders.


## Quilting and Finishing:

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
