

GO! Baby Sweet Baby Throw Quilt

Finished Size: 40" x 50"



Fabrics provided by Andover Fabrics.

Dies Needed:

GO! Qube Mix & Match 8" Block (55776)

- GO! Square-4-1/2" (4" Finished) (Shape 1)
- GO! Half Square Triangle-4" Finished Square (Shape 3)
- GO! Rectangle-2-1/2" x 4-1/2" (2' x 4" Finished) (Shape 8)

Additional Dies Needed

- GO! Pennants (55149)
- GO! Carefree Alphabet Uppercase Set (2-Die Set) (55092)
- GO! Strip Cutter 2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)
- GO! Strip Cutter 3-1/2" (3" Finished) (55032)

Fabric Requirements:

Fabric Color	Total Yardage
Dark Gray	3/4 yard
Aqua #1	5/8 yard
Yellow	5/8 yard
Light Blue	3/8 yard
White	1 yard
Aqua #2	3/4 yard—includes binding
Light Gray	3/8 yard
Batting	48" x 58"
Backing	60" x 70"
Fusible	1-1/4 yards

Cutting Directions:

Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut
Dark Gray	GO! Rectangle 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" (2" x 4" finished) (Shape 8)	Cut 3—5" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Fanfold into 5-1/2" widths. Sub cut into 30—2" x 4" finished rectangles.
Aqua #1	GO! Square 4-1/2" (4" finished) (Shape 1)	Cut 4—5" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 5" widths. Sub cut into 30—4" finished squares.
Yellow	GO! Square 4-1/2" (4" finished) (Shape 1)	Cut 4—5" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 5" widths. Sub cut into 30—4" finished squares.
Light Blue	GO! Rectangle 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" (2" x 4" finished) (Shape 8)	Cut 2—5" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Fanfold into 5-1/2" widths. Sub cut into 20—2" x 4" finished rectangles.
White	GO! Half Square Triangle 4" finished Square (Shape 3)	Cut 3—5-3/8" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 5-3/8" widths. Sub cut into 40—4" finished half square triangles (HST).
Aqua #2 and Light Gray	GO! Half Square Triangle 4" finished Square (Shape 3)	Cut 2—5-3/8" x WOF strips each color. Fanfold into 5-3/8" widths. Sub cut into 20—4" finished HST each color.
Aqua #2	GO! Strip Cutter 2-1/2" (2" finished)	Cut 5—2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.
White	GO! Pennants (55149)	Cut 2—7-1/2" x WOF strips. Apply fusible to wrong side of strips according to manufacturer's instruction. Sub cut into 4 round bottom, 5 double point and 4 single point pennants.
Dark Gray	GO! Strip Cutter 3-1/2" (3" finished)	Cut 2—3-1/2" strips. Apply fusible to wrong side of strips according to manufacturer's instruction. Sub cut into 13—3-1/2" squares.
Dark Gray	GO! Carefree Alphabet Set (55092)	Use 12—3-1/2" squares from above cut. Lay fabric side up over letters and cut 4-B's, 2 each A, E, Y and 1 each S and T. Use 1—3-1/2" x 4-3/4" rectangle to cut 1 W.

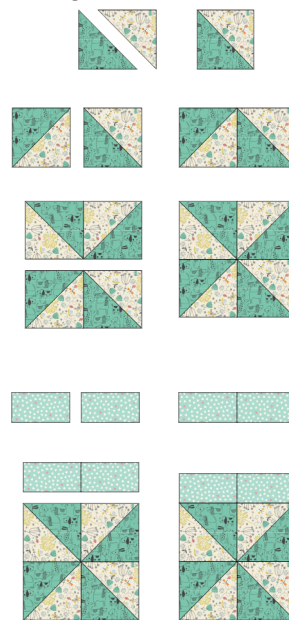
Sewing Directions:

Press all seams open and use 1/4" seams, unless otherwise indicated.

Sashed Pinwheel Block

NOTE: Directions will be for one 8" x 10" finished block. Make 5 Aqua #2 and 4 Light Gray.

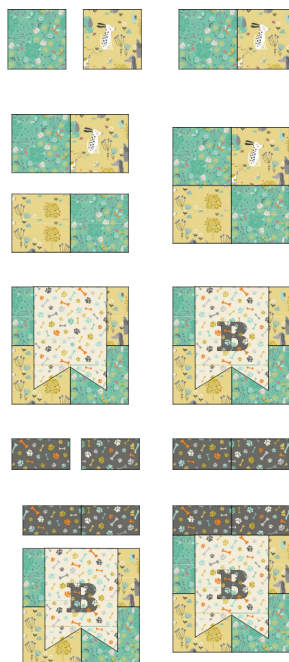
1. Sew one aqua #2 and white 4" finished half square triangle (HST) (Shape 3) together. Make 4 HST units.
2. Sew two HST units together as shown. Make 2 half block units.
3. Sew two half block units together as shown. Make 1 pinwheel unit.
4. Sew two light blue 2" x 4" finished rectangles (Shape 8) together on short sides. Make 1 sash unit.
5. Sew sash unit to top of pinwheel unit as shown. Make 1 Sashed Pinwheel block.



Sashed Four Patch Block

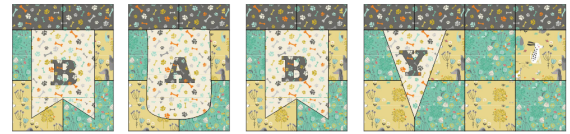
NOTE: Directions will be for one 8" x 10" finished block. Make 13 Pennant Patch and 2 Four Patch blocks.

1. Sew one aqua #1 and one yellow 4" finished squares (Shape 1) together. Make 2 half block units.
2. Sew two half block units together. Make 1 four-patch.
3. Apply pennant shape to four-patch aligning tops. Machine stitch in place. Make 1 pennant four patch.
4. Apply one alphabet letter to pennant patch. Machine stitch in place. Make 1 letter/pennant four-patch.
5. Sew two dark gray 2" x 4" finished rectangles (Shape 8) together on short sides. Make 1 sash unit.
6. Sew sash unit to top of letter/ pennant four-patch unit. Make 1 Sashed Pennant Four Patch block.



Assemble the Quilt Top

1. Lay out blocks in 5 rows of 5 blocks each as shown in quilt diagram. Sew blocks together into rows. Press seams to one side.
2. Sew rows together. Press seams in opposite directions



Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
