| ASSORTED FALL PRINTS | GO! Maple <br> Leaf-8" <br> Finished (55195) | From each fabric, cut 1-4" x 8" strip. Fanfold into 4" widths. Sub cut 4-B Half Square Triangles (HST) shapes. |
| ASSORTED FALL PRINTS | GO! Maple <br> Leaf-8" <br> Finished (55195) | From each fabric, cut $1-3-3 / 4$ " square. Sub cut 1—D stem shape. |
| RED | GO! Strip Cutter-21/4" (1-3/4" Finished) (55053) | Cut 5-2-1/4" x WOF strips for binding. |

Cut 1-3-3/4" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 3-3/4" widths. Sub cut 20-A square shapes.

Cut 2-3-3/4" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 3-3/4" widths. Sub cut 40-C HST shapes.

Cut 4—2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub cut $2-2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ 36-1/2" strips and 2—2-1/2" x 40-1/2" for borders.

Note: Label each shape cut as soon as possible to avoid confusion.

## Sewing Directions:

Use $1 / 4$ " seams, unless otherwise indicated.

## MAPLE LEAF BLOCK

NOTE: Directions will be for one 8 " finished block. Please also refer to die package instructions.

1. Sew together one fall color $B$ and one white $B$ to make a BB HST square.
2. Make 4 identical BB HST squares.
3. Sew one white C HST to both sides of a fall color D stem shape to make the stem square unit.

4. Layout four BB HST squares, three fall color A squares, one white $A$ square and one stem square unit as shown.
5. Sew squares within each row together. Then, sew rows together to complete one Maple Leaf Block.
6. Make 20 Maple Leaf Blocks.


## Assemble the Quilt Top

1. Lay out 20 Maple Leaf Blocks, rotating each one as shown. Sew blocks together in each row. Sew rows together to complete the quilt center.
2. Sew one white $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ to opposite sides of the quilt center
3. Then, sew one white $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 36-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the top and bottom of the quilt center.

## Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
