Dies Needed:

GO! Maple Leaf-8" Finished (55195)

Additional Dies Needed

- GO! Strip Cutter-2-1/4" (1-3/4" Finished) (55053)
- GO! Strip Cutter-2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)

Fabric Requirements:

Fabric Color	Total Yardage
ASSORTED FALL PRINTS	Twenty Fat Eighths
RED	1/2 yard
WHITE	1 1/4 yards
Batting	44" x 52"
Backing	44" x 52"





Cutting Directions:

Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut
ASSORTED FALL PRINTS	GO! Maple Leaf-8" Finished (55195)	From each fabric, cut 1—3-3/4" x 11-1/4" strip. Fanfold into 3-3/4" widths. Sub cut 3—A square shapes.
ASSORTED FALL PRINTS	GO! Maple Leaf-8" Finished (55195)	From each fabric, cut 1—4" x 8" strip. Fanfold into 4" widths. Sub cut 4—B Half Square Triangles (HST) shapes.
ASSORTED FALL PRINTS	GO! Maple Leaf-8" Finished (55195)	From each fabric, cut 1—3-3/4" square. Sub cut 1—D stem shape.
RED	GO! Strip Cutter-2- 1/4" (1-3/4" Finished) (55053)	Cut 5—2-1/4" x WOF strips for binding.
WHITE	GO! Maple Leaf-8" Finished (55195)	Cut 1—3-3/4" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 3-3/4" widths. Sub cut 20—A square shapes.
WHITE	GO! Maple Leaf-8" Finished (55195)	Cut 4—4" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 4" widths. Sub cut 80—B HST shapes.
WHITE	GO! Maple Leaf-8" Finished (55195)	Cut 2—3-3/4" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 3-3/4" widths. Sub cut 40—C HST shapes.
WHITE	GO! Strip Cutter-2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)	Cut 4—2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub cut 2—2-1/2" x 36-1/2" strips and 2—2-1/2" x 40-1/2" for borders.

Note: Label each shape cut as soon as possible to avoid confusion.






Sewing Directions:

Use 1/4" seams, unless otherwise indicated.

MAPLE LEAF BLOCK

NOTE: Directions will be for one 8" finished block. Please also refer to die package instructions.

- Sew together one fall color B and one white B to make a BB HST square.
- 2. Make 4 identical BB HST squares.
- 3. Sew one white C HST to both sides of a fall color D stem shape to make the stem square unit.
- 4. Layout four BB HST squares, three fall color A squares, one white A square and one stem square unit as shown.
- 5. Sew squares within each row together. Then, sew rows together to complete one Maple Leaf Block.
- Make 20 Maple Leaf Blocks.











Assemble the Quilt Top

- 1. Lay out 20 Maple Leaf Blocks, rotating each one as shown. Sew blocks together in each row. Sew rows together to complete the quilt center.
- 2. Sew one white 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" to opposite sides of the quilt center
- 3. Then, sew one white 2-1/2" x 36-1/2" strip to the top and bottom of the quilt center.

Quilting and Finishing

- Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
- Pin or baste layers together.
- 3. Quilt as desired.
- 4. Add binding, mitering corners.
