



GO! Maple Leaf Sunflowers Throw Quilt Finished Size: 55" x 55"







Dies Needed:

GO! Maple Leaf-8" Finished (55195)

Additional Dies (optional)

• GO! Strip Cutter 2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55014 or 55017)

Fabric Requirements:

Fabric Color	Total Yardage	
Yellow	1 2/3 yard total	
Orange	1-yard total	
Red Orange	1-yard total	
Brown (includes binding)	1 3/4-yard total	
Tan	1/2 yard total	
Backing	3 1/2 yards	
Batting	60" x 60"	





Cutting Directions:

Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut
Orange	GO! Maple Leaf-8" Finished (55195)	Cut $80 - 3-1/2$ " squares. Place on selected blade A and cut. Cut $8 - 4$ " squares. Place on selected blade B and cut.
Yellow	GO! Maple Leaf-8" Finished (55195)	Cut 64 – 3-1/2" squares. Place on selected blade A and cut. Cut 56 – 4" squares. Place on selected blade B and cut. Cut 16 – 3-1/2" squares. Place on selected blade C and cut.
Red Orange	GO! Maple Leaf-8" Finished (55195)	Cut 8 – 3-1/2" squares. Place on selected blade A and cut. Cut 56 – 4" squares. Place on selected blade B and cut.
Tan	GO! Maple Leaf-8" Finished (55195)	Cut 16 – 2" x 5" rectangles. Place on selected blade D and cut.
Tan	GO! Strip Cutter 2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55014)	Cut 1 – 3" x WOF strip. Place on selected blade and cut. Sub-cut into 13 – 2-1/2" squares.
Brown	GO! Strip Cutter 2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55014)	Cut 10 – 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Place on selected blade and cut. Set aside 6 strips for border. Set aside 6 strips for binding. Sub-cut 8 strips into 16 – 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" strips.





Sewing Directions:

Press all seams open and use 1/4" seams, unless otherwise indicated.

Maple Leaf

NOTE: Directions will be for one 8" finished block. Make 16 blocks.

Sew two yellow C pieces to one tan D piece together as shown to create stem. Press seams open.



2. Sew one yellow B piece to one red orange B piece together to create a HST. Press seams open. Make 4 HST units.



3. Layout four HST units, one yellow square, three orange squares, and stem unit as shown.



4. Sew pieces together into three rows, pressing seams open between units.



5. Sew three units to create Maple Leafe block. Press seams open.







<Border Triangle>

NOTE: Directions will be for one 22-1/2" x 11-1/2" finished block. Make 8 blocks.

1. Sew one yellow B piece to one red orange B piece together to create a HST. Press seams open. Make 4 HST units.



2. Sew two red orange B pieces to one red orange A square as shown.



3. Sew one yellow and one orange C piece to one yellow A square as shown. Make 2 units, following color order.




4. Sew one orange A square to one yellow A square piece. Make 3 two-patch units.



5. Layout your four HST units, three two-patch units, three triangle units, one yellow A square and one orange A square as shown.




- 6. Sew two HST units to the red orange triangle unit. Press seams open.
- 7. Sew two HST units and yellow A square to set. Press seams open.








8. Sew one two-patch and orange A square to set. Press seams open.



9. Sew two two-patch units to set. Press seams open.



10. Sew two triangle units to set, paying close attention to color order. Press seams open.








Assemble the Quilt Top

1. Lay out blocks as shown in quilt diagram. Sew maple leaf blocks together into sets of four. Press seams open.







- 2. Sew blocks to sashing in diagonal rows. Press seams to one side.
- 3. Sew sashing and cornerstones together. Press seams to one side.
- 4. Sew rows and sashing together. Press seams to one side. Trim off the excess points from the cornerstones to square the quilt.
- 5. Sew the six brown border 2-1/2" strips together for the border pieces.
- 6. Measure your quilt side lengths. Sub-cut the brown border strip into two side border sections at this measurement.
- 7. Sew the two side borders to the quilt. Press seams out to the border.
- 8. Measure your top quilt width. Sub-cut the brown border piece into two top border sections at this measurement.
- 9. Sew the two top borders to the quilt. Press seams out to the border.





Quilting and Finishing

- Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
- Pin or baste layers together.
- 3. Quilt as desired.
- Add binding, mitering corners.
