Cutting Directions:

Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut
Cream	GO! Square-6-1/2" (6" Finished) (55000)	Cut 3 WOF 7" strips. Fanfold into 7" widths. Sub cut into 15—6-1/2" x 6-1/2" squares.
Cream	GO! Strip Cutter-1-1/2" (1" Finished) 5 Strips Die (55024)	Cut 6—1-1/2" WOF strips. (Side borders will be pieced.)
Red	GO! Strip Cutter-1-1/2" (1" Finished) 5 Strips Die (55024)	Cut 6—2-1/2" WOF strips. (Side borders will be pieced)
Red	GO! Square-2" (1-1/2" Finished) (55702)	Cut 1—4-1/2" WOF strips. Fanfold. Sub cut into 24—2" (1-1/2" finished) squares.
Green	GO! Chisels-1-1/2" x 3" Finished (Shape 9)	Cut 3—6" x WOF Strips. DO NOT FANFOLD. Place fabric on die <u>either Right Side Down, or Right Side up – but be consistent!</u> Sub cut into 76--1-1/2" x 3" chisels.
White	GO! Half Square Triangle-1-1/2" Finished Square (55705)	Cut 2—5-1/4" x WOF Strips. Fanfold Subcut into 76—1-1/2" Half Square Triangles
Assorted Fabrics	GO! Gingerbread Cookie (55862)	Cut and fuse assorted fabric scraps. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 15 Gingerbread, brown scraps
Assorted Fabrics	GO! Cookie Decorations (55211)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 15 bows, red scraps • 4 hearts, red scraps • 4 dresses, green scraps • 22 dots, black fabric • 7 dots, red fabric scraps

Sewing Directions:

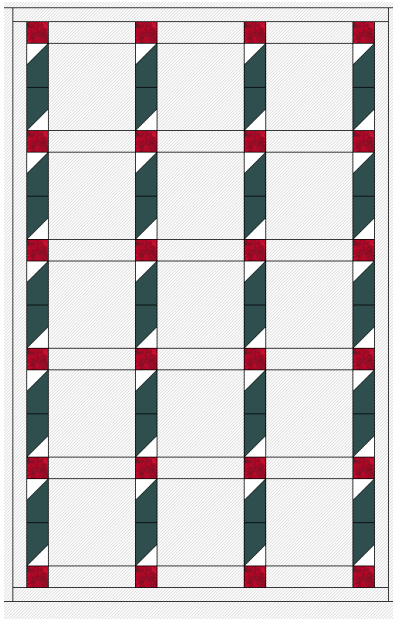
Press all seams to the dark side and use 1/4" seams, unless otherwise indicated.

SASHING

1. Attach a chisel to a half-square triangle. Repeat to make 76 units. (Make sure all units face same direction.)
2. Sew two chisel units together, forming a 1-1/2" x 6" unit. Repeat to make 38 units.
3. Set 18 of the 6" units to the side. Use the remaining units, along with your red squares to create your vertical sashing. (6 red squares and 5 chisel/HST pairs sewn together will create a piece of sashing 33" long.) Set these aside as well.



You will have 4 of these vertical units to use in your quilt!



APPLIQUE BLOCKS

NOTE: Directions will be for one 6X6" finished block. Make 15 blocks.

1. Attach fusible to back of brown scrap fabrics. Cut out 15 gingerbread shapes.
2. Attach fusible to the back of green and red scraps. Cut out hearts, bows, eyes and nose shapes.
3. Center the 6-1/2" x 6-1/2" cream background fabric on your embroidery machine and attach figures. Layer items appropriately.

If you do not have an embroidery machine, iron items to center of cream background fabric and use sewing machine to blanket stitch items securely to background.



Assemble the Quilt Top

1. Lay out Quilt following this plan:
 - a. Lay out blocks in 5 rows of 3 columns each.
 - b. Lay out sashing between blocks, with a chisel/HST unit above each appliqued block, as well as a chisel/HST unit below the final row.
 - c. Lay out long vertical sashing on the right side and left side of the quilt blocks, as well as two more sashings in the middle of quilt.
2. Sew a chisel/hst unit to the top of all 15 applique blocks.
Sew a chisel/hst unit to the bottom of 3 of those blocks, the ones for the bottom row.
3. Combine the 5 applique blocks in first column, with their top/bottom sashing, to form a column. Review to quilt picture for placement of individual blocks
 - a. Repeat 2 more times, creating a total of 3 applique rows.
4. Sew the columns together, alternating them with the sashing rows.
5. Add the first and second borders.

Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
