## CUTTING DIRECTIONS for Traditional Version

Fabric 1:

- Cut $9 — 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
- Cut 8-2" finished half square triangles


Traditional Fabric Quilt Diagram

Fabric 2:

- Cut $16-41 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ squares
- Cut 8-2½" squares
- Cut $104-2$ finished half square triangles

Fabric 3:

- Cut $24-4 ½ 1$ squares

Fabric 4:

- Cut $16-2 ½$ " squares
- Cut 96-2" finished half square triangles
- Cut $4-21 / 2 "$ strips across the width of fabric (WOF) for binding


## SEWING DIRECTIONS

1. Pin and sew eight, Fabric \#1 and Fabric \#2, 2" finished half square triangles (HST) together. Press seams toward darker fabric.
2. Pin and sew 96, Fabric \#2 and Fabric \#4, 2" finished HST together. Press seams toward
 darker fabric.
3. Pin and sew one Fabric \#2 and three Fabric \#4, $21 / 2$ " squares together to make a 4-Patch unit. Make four.
4. Pin and sew two, Fabric \#1 and Fabric \#2 combined finished HST together. Make four.

5. Pin and sew two, Fabric \#2 and Fabric \#4 combined finished HST together. Make four.
6. Pin and sew combined units together as shown. Make four.
7. Lay out center block units as shown at right. Pin and sew together.


## SEWING DIRECTIONS Cont.

8. Lay out Fabric \#1 and Fabric \#3, $41 / 2$ " squares as shown. Pin and sew together. Press seams toward darker
 fabric. Make two. Pin and sew one combined unit to each side of center block. Press seams toward $41 / 2$ " squares.
9. Lay out Fabric \#1 and Fabric \#3, 4½" squares as shown. Pin and sew
 together. Press seams toward darker fabric. Make two.
10. Pin and sew one combined unit to top and bottom of center block.
11. Pin and sew two, Fabric \#2 and Fabric \#4 combined finished HST together as shown.
 Make 20.
12. Pin and sew two, Fabric \#2 and Fabric \#4 combined finished HST together as shown. Make 20.
13. Pin and sew combined units together as shown. Make 20.

14. Pin and sew five sets of combined units together to form pieced border strips. Make four.
15. Pin and sew two border strips to sides of quilt center. Press seams toward $41 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
16. Pin and sew two, Fabric \#2 and Fabric \#4 combined finished HST together with one each Fabric \#2 and Fabric \#4, $2^{1 ⁄ 21}$ square into a
 4-Patch unit as shown. Make four.
17. Pin and sew one 4-Patch unit to each end of pieced border strip following quilt diagram for orientation.
18. Pin and sew one combined pieced border strip and 4-Patch unit to top and bottom of quilt center.
19. Layout Fabric \#2 and Fabric \#3, $41 / 2$ " squares for outer border according to quilt diagram. Pin and sew squares together into strips.
20. Pin and sew strips to quilt center to complete quilt top.

## QUILTING \& FINISHING

1. Layer quilt top with batting and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Model was machine quilted with an all-over design.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.

Fabric 1:

- Cut $16-21 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ squares
- Cut 96-2" finished half square triangles

Fabric 2:

- Cut 24-4½" squares
- Cut 4-2½" squares
- Cut $16-2$ " finished half square triangles

Fabric 3:

- Cut 25-4½" squares
- Cut $4-21 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ squares
- Cut 96-2" finished half square triangles


## SEWING DIRECTIONS

Follow sewing directions for Traditional GO! For It Quilt following Bright Quilt diagram and substituting fabrics.
