¼ yard	Basketweave - Brown (B)	8555-39
⅝ yard	Brands - Red (C)	8554-88
1 ⅛ yards	Horseshoes - Tan (D)	8556-35
¼ yard	Bandana Print - Red (E)	8558-88
⅜ yard	Horseshoes - Brown (F)	8556-39
⅜ yard	Brands - Blue (G)	8554-75
1 ⅛ yards	Rope - Tan (H)	8559-35
⅝ yard	Horse Heads - Gray (I)	8553-90
⅜ yard	Bandana Print - Denim (J)	8558-75
1 ⅓ yards	Rodeo Toss - Ivory (K)	8551-41
1 ⅞ yards	Splash - Night (L)	3504-Night*
5 yards	Rodeo Toile - Gray (Backing)	8557-90

### Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Cowboy Boots & Horseshoes - Blue (A), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (5) 4 ½" squares.

#### From the Basketweave - Brown (B), cut:

- (1) 5 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (5) 5 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (20) triangles.

#### From the Brands - Red (C), cut:

- (2) 5 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (15) 5 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (60) triangles.
- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (30) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the Horseshoes - Tan (D), cut:

- (2) 5 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (10) 5 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (40) triangles.
- (5) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (40) 4 ½" squares.

#### From the Bandana Print - Red (E), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (5) 4 ½" squares.

#### From the Horseshoes - Brown (F), cut:

- (2) 5 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (15) 5 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (60) triangles.

#### From the Brands - Blue (G), cut:

- (2) 5 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (10) 5 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (40) triangles.

#### From the Rope - Tan (H), cut:

- (2) 5 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (10) 5 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (40) triangles.
- (5) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (40) 4 ½" squares.

#### From the Horse Heads - Gray (I), cut:

- (2) 5 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (10) 5 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (40) triangles.

#### From the Bandana Print - Denim (J), cut:

- (1) 5 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (5) 5 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (20) triangles.
- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (5) 4 ½" squares.

#### From the Rodeo Toss - Ivory (K), cut:

- (4) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 72 ½" strips.
- (4) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 68 ½" strips.

#### From the Splash - Night (L), cut:

- (17) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (49) 2 ½" x 12 ½" strips.
- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Rodeo Toile - Gray (Backing), cut:

- (2) 90" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 76" x 90" back.

### Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (2) Fabric C triangles, (1) Fabric D triangle and (1) Fabric B triangle together to make (1) Unit 1 (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (20) Unit 1 blocks.
2. Sew (2) Fabric G triangles, (1) Fabric H triangle and (1) Fabric F triangle together to make (1) Unit 2 (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (20) Unit 2 blocks.
3. Sew (2) Fabric F triangles, (1) Fabric H triangle and (1) Fabric J triangle together to make (1) Unit 3 (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (20) Unit 3 blocks.
4. Sew (2) Fabric I triangles, (1) Fabric D triangle and (1) Fabric C triangle together to make (1) Unit 4 (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (20) Unit 4 blocks.

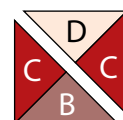

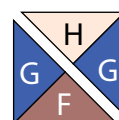

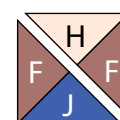

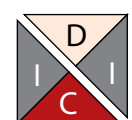

5. Sew (1) Unit 1 to each side of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 4 1/2" Fabric D square to each side of (1) Unit 1. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Block One (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (5) Block Ones total.

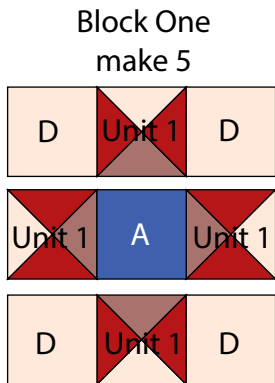

6. Sew (1) Unit 2 to each side of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric E square. Sew (1) 4 1/2" Fabric H square to each side of (1) Unit 2. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E square to make (1) Block Two (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (5) Block Twos total.

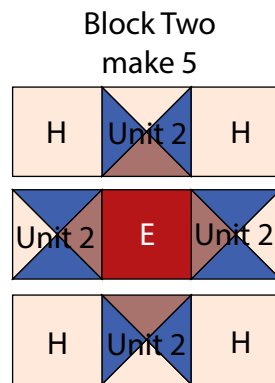

7. Sew (1) Unit 3 to each side of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric I square. Sew (1) 4 1/2" Fabric H square to each side of (1) Unit 3. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric I square to make (1) Block Three (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (5) Block Threes total.

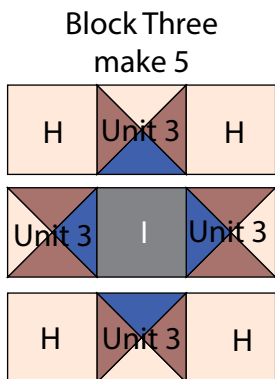

8. Sew (1) Unit 4 to each side of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric J square. Sew (1) 4 1/2" Fabric D square to each side of (1) Unit 4. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric J square to make (1) Block Four (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (5) Block Fours total.

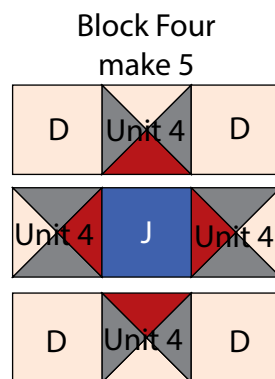

9. Sew (5) 2 1/2" Fabric C squares and (4) 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric L strips together end to end and alternating them to make (1) sashing row (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (6) sashing rows total.

### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)*

10. Sew (5) 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric L strips and (4) assorted blocks together, alternating them, to make (1) row. Repeat to make (5) rows total.

11. Sew the (6) sashing strips and (5) rows together alternating them to make the Center Block.

12. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 72 1/2" Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 68 1/2" Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

13. Layer and quilt as desired.

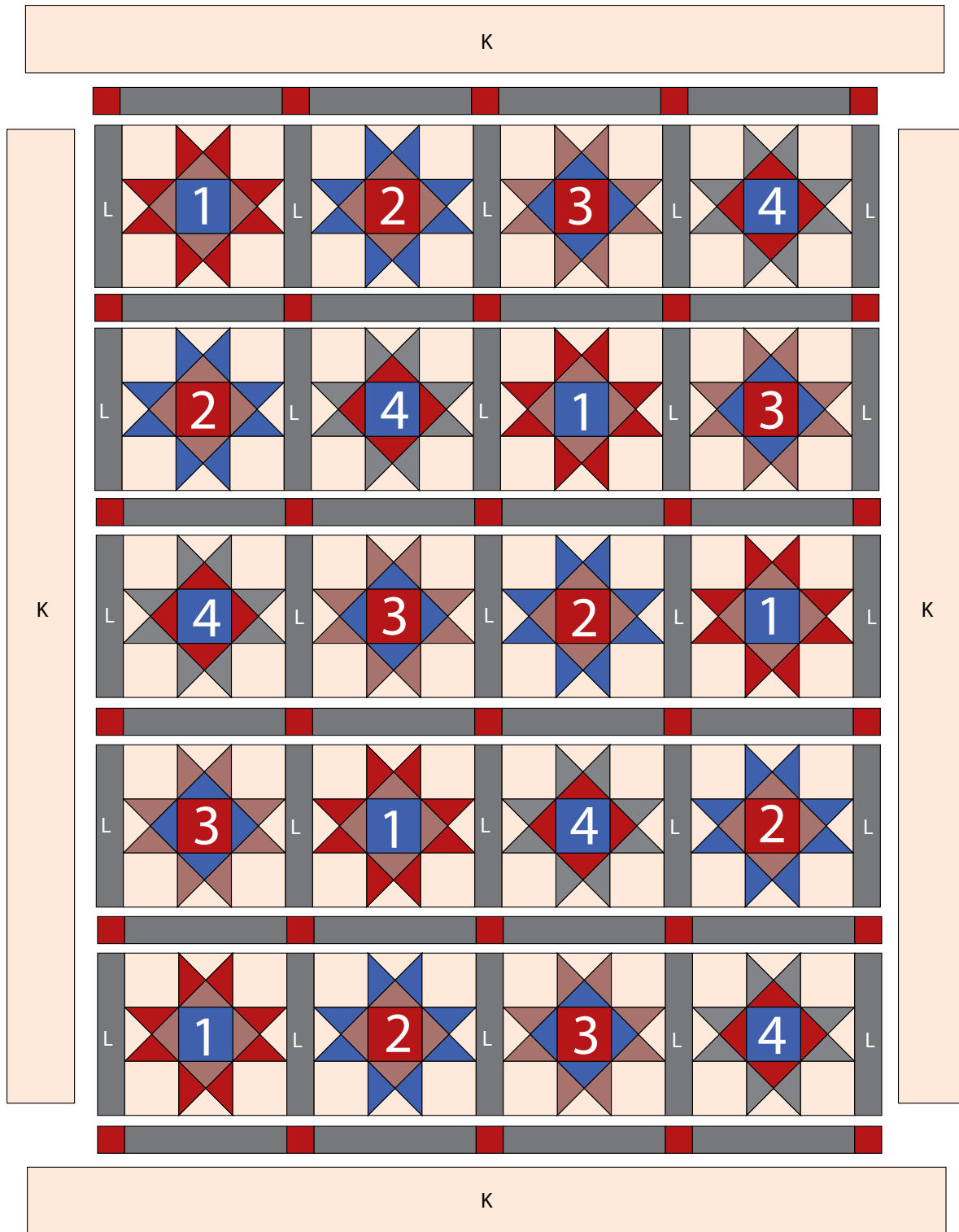
14. Sew the (8) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric L strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

15. Bind as desired.
