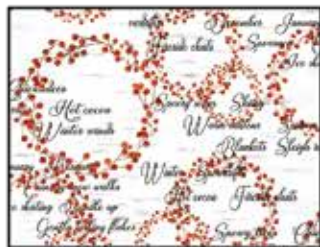

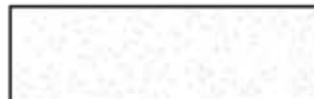

Materials

1 panel	Snowman Panel - Blue (A)	1635P-11
$\frac{2}{3}$ yard	Faded Stars - Red (B)	1632-88
$\frac{3}{8}$ yard	Swirling Snowflakes - Gray (C)	1637-90
$\frac{3}{8}$ yard	Faded Stars - Blue (D)	1632-11
$1\frac{2}{3}$ yards	Novelty Stripe Snowmen and Animals - Blue/Red (E)	1641-89
$\frac{1}{2}$ yard	Swirling Snowflakes - Red (F)	1637-88*
$3\frac{1}{2}$ yards	Snowmen and Animals Allover - Blue (Backing)	1638-11

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Snowman Panel - Blue (A):

- Fussy cut (1) $19\frac{1}{4}$ " x $32\frac{3}{4}$ " panel.

From the Faded Stars - Red (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x $22\frac{1}{4}$ " WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x $32\frac{3}{4}$ " WOF strips.
- (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $42\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $30\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.

From the Swirling Snowflakes - Gray (C), cut:

- (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips.

From the Faded Stars - Blue (D), cut:

- (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips.

From the Novelty Stripe Snowmen and Animals - Blue/Red (E), cut:

- (2) 4" x 55" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) 4" x 41" LOF strips.

From the Swirling Snowflakes - Red (F), cut:

- (5) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Snowmen and Animals - Blue (Backing), cut:

- (2) 59" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 45" x 59" back.

Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) 2" x $32\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the $19\frac{1}{4}$ " x $32\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x $22\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure $20\frac{1}{2}$ " x $34\frac{1}{2}$ " to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

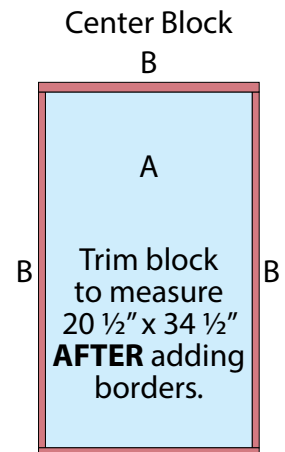

2. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric C strip and (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric D strip together lengthwise to make (1) Strip Set (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (4) Strip Sets total.

3. Cut the (4) Strip Sets into (62) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 1 strips (Fig. 3).

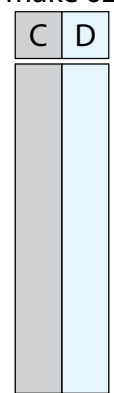

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

4. Sew (17) Unit 1 strips together lengthwise, rotating each 180-degrees, to make (1) Side Border. Repeat to make a second Side Border. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block.

5. Sew (14) Unit 1 strips together lengthwise, rotating each 180-degrees, to make the Top Border. Repeat to make the Bottom Border. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

6. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $42\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $30\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

7. Center (1) 4" x 55" Fabric E strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the top edge of the block and stop a $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.

8. Repeat Step 7 to sew (1) 4" x 41" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 4).

9. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 4), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the quilt top.

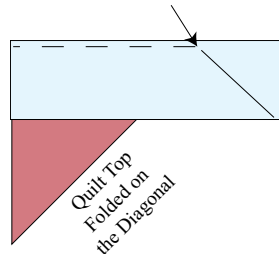
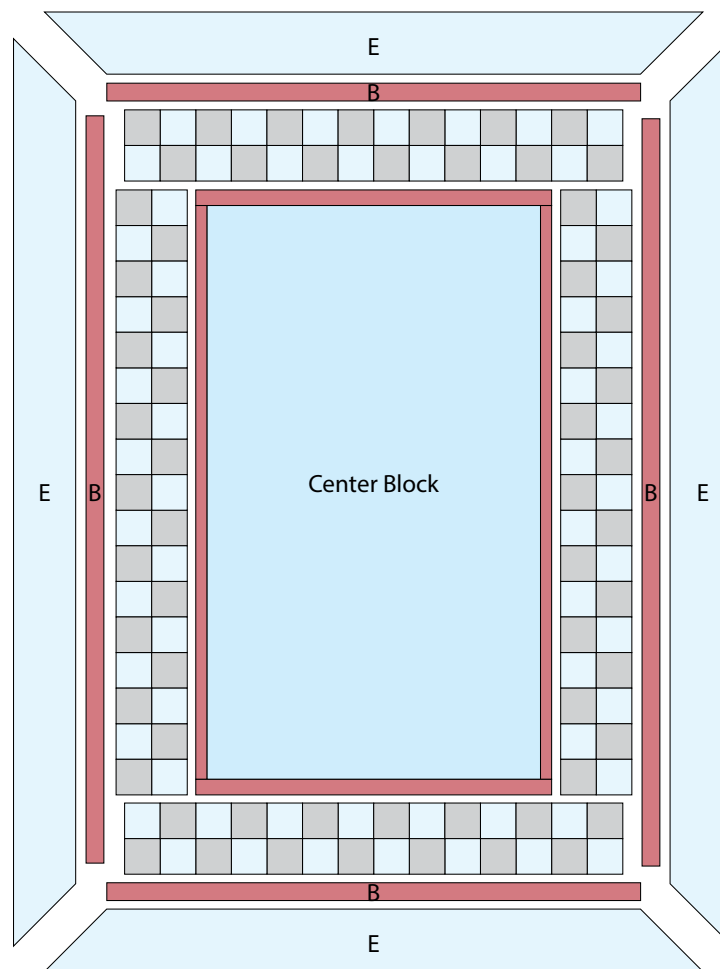

10. Layer and quilt as desired.

11. Sew the (5) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric F strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

12. Bind as desired.
