

GO! Scottie Dog Table Runner

Finished Size: 16" x 36"



Dies Needed:

GO! Scottie Dog (55224)

GO! Qube Mix & Match 12" Block (55778)

- **GO! Square-6-1/2" (6" Finished) (Shape 1)**

Additional Dies (optional)

- GO! Strip Cutter-1-1/2" (1" Finished) (55024)
- GO! Strip Cutter-2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)
- GO! Square-1-1/2" (1" Finished) (55470)

Fabric Requirements:

| Fabric Color | Total Yardage |
|--------------------|---------------|
| Black Solid | 3/8 yard |
| Black Check Design | 3/4 yard |
| White | 1/4 yard |
| Deep Red | 3/8 yard |
| Binding | 1/4 yard* |
| Batting | 20" x 40" |
| Backing | 20" x 40" |

* The estimate for this fabric yardage assumes width of fabric (WOF) strips are sewn together before cutting. Recommend use of black check or dark red for binding.

Cutting Directions:

| Fabric Color | Die | Number of Shapes to Cut |
|--------------|---|---|
| White | GO! Square-6-1/2" (6" Finished) (Shape 1) | Cut 1—7" x width of fabric (WOF) strip. Fanfold into 7" widths. Sub cut into 3 squares. |
| Black | GO! Scottie Dog (55224) | Cut 3 applique shapes. Place all layers face up. Fusible web should be applied before cutting. Leave paper on until ready to apply to fabric. |
| Black | GO! Strip Cutter-1-1/2" (1" Finished) (55024) | Cut 2 WOF strips and cut into 12—6-1/2" x 1-1/2" strips. |
| Dark Red | GO! Strip Cutter-1-1/2" (1" Finished) (55024) | Cut 2—WOF strips for inside border. Sub cut each WOF into one 10-1/2" strip and one 32-1/2" strip. You will have two long strips (32-1/2") and two short strips (10-1/2") |
| Dark Red | GO! Square-1-1/2" (1" Finished) (55470) | Cut 1—5-1/2" x WOF strip. Cut 9—1-1/2" Squares. Cut 1—2" x 2" square of scrap to cut 1 additional square. 6 squares total (cut 4 in half). |
| Black Check | Rotary Cutter | Cut 1—9-1/4" x 9-1/4" square of fabric. Sub cut square into 4 quarters diagonally (like an X) to create 4 QST. |
| Black Check | Rotary Cutter | Cut 1—8-7/8" x 8-7/8" square of fabric. Sub cut the square diagonally to create 2 HST. |
| Black Check | GO! Strip Cutter-2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017) | Cut 3—2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew all three strips together and sub cut: 2—36-1/2" long 2—12-1/2" long |
| Binding | GO! Strip Cutter-2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017) | Cut 1—8" x WOF strip. Sub cut into 3—2-1/2" strips and sew together to make binding. Total of 104" of binding needed. |

Sewing Directions:

Press all seams open and use 1/4" seams, unless otherwise indicated.

Scottie Dog

1. White fabric square is set diagonally – block should be rotated accordingly before placing the applique shape.
2. Remove fusible paper from back of applique shape.
3. Place the pre-fused Scottie Dog applique shape on the 6-1/2" white fabric square. Be sure to place exactly in center, taking into account the 1/4" seam allowance on each side of the block
4. Press according to fusible directions.
5. Sew 1 each (6 total) of the 6-1/2" x 1-1/2" cut black strips to opposite sides of each of the 3 completed applique blocks as shown.



Black/Red Sashing

1. Sew dark red 2-1/2" squares to the remaining six 6-1/2" x 1-1/2" (6" x 2" finished) strips.
2. Back strips as follows:
 - a. Two black strips – sew one square to the right side of each strip.
 - b. Four black strips – sew one square to each side of the remaining black strips.

Assembling Squares, Sashing, and Setting Triangles


The Scottie Dog blocks are set on point, requiring the use of setting triangles and the black/red sashing strips for the sides.

1. Lay out the pattern as shown below with HST and QST.
2. Start sewing with row 2.
3. Once row 2 is completed, go back and sew on single QST in row 1.

4. Sew rows 3, 4 and finally the remaining QST in row 5.

5. Sew completed rows together to make the center of the table runner

* Note: the outside squares must be cut down to properly align. Once borders are sewn, excess can be trimmed before final pressing



Adding Borders

First Border – Dark Red

1. Sew the shorter dark red strips to the short sides of assembled Scottie Dog panel.
2. Sew the two longer dark red strips to the long sides of the assembled Scottie Dog panel.

Second Border – Black Check

1. Sew the shorter black check strips to the short sides of the assembled Scottie Dog panel.
2. Sew the two longer black check strips to the long sides of the assembled Scottie Dog Panel.

Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing. Note the cut sizes given were slightly larger than the finished quilt top to improve ease of trimming final product
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired
4. Once quilted, trim excess batting and backing to create smooth line around the edge of the quilt



Binding

1. Sew the 2-1/2" strips together to make binding. Miter the seams to reduce bulk. Approximately 104" total of binding needed
2. Press the 2-1/2" sewn strips in half to make binding
3. Attach binding to wrong side of quilt. Fold over binding to front side of quilt (mitering corners) and top stitch to finish.
