Judy Neimeyer pattern of your choice. If you don't have one, you can purchase one from the instructor. Choose a pattern from Judy's website and email Catherine (address at bottom of this page.) Basic sewing supplies. If you aren't sure what this is, please download it from our website or ask for a copy at the quilt counter in the shop

Sewing machine, cord, foot control, feet, manual. Machine in good working order. Please do not bring a brand new machine to class. You must be familiar with the way your machine works.

Add a Quarter Ruler - 12" or 18"

50wt thread (I prefer Aurifil or DMC)

1 sheet of Heavy Duty Mylar plastic OR 1 office file folder (manila or colored)

Sew Line Glue Pen and refills

Gallon Size Ziploc Bags—6

rotary cutter (preferably the 60mm, 45 mm minimum)

cutting mat

iron and ironing mat

scotch tape, blue painter's tape

medium sized binder clips

6 ½" x 12 ½" ruler

Paper

Scissors

Binder clips

paper clips

Purple Thang

Flower head pins

standard sewing kit • seam ripper • snips • etc

Pre-Class Prep Instruction (if you have your pattern.) • Prep your papers -- cut out all of the shapes on your papers ⅛" outside of the outside line of each shape. Group the like shapes together with a paper clip or binder clip. Do not cut the templates.
