



Precision Pieced Spikey Table Runner Workshop

Workshop Descriptive: Grab just one charm pack plus two neutrals and you're ready to go! Coloured triangles create a swirling 3-D effect on this modern and contemporary project! With Linda's guidance, this workshop gives beginners and advanced piecers the opportunity to perfect their 1/4" seam and fine tune piecing skills while creating this fun table runner.

Materials List:

- "Mini Spikey" Pattern by Colourwerx (CW-113)
- Fabric Requirements:
 1. Table Runner (12" x 48")
 - a. Background Fabric - 1/2 yard
 - b. Coloured Spikes (triangles) - (1) Charm Pack (with at least 20 5" squares)
 - c. Outer Border/Binding: 5/8 yard
 2. (1) Spool of a Coordinating Colour of 100% Cotton 50wt Thread (or similar brand) for Piecing
 3. Optional: Creative Grids 30° Triangle #CGRSG1 or Template Plastic to Cut Out Triangle Pattern Shape
 4. 24" Straight Rotary Ruler and Rotary Cutter
 6. Fabric Marking Pen (iron off or water soluble preferred)



You will also need these other sewing items to complete this project:

- Sewing Machine in good working condition - please bring your manual, cord, foot pedal and presser feet
- 1/4" Seam Presser Foot for your Sewing Machine
- Basic Sewing Supplies such as: straight pins (long glasshead pins work best), scissors, marking pencil or pen; seam ripper, etc...

Before Class:

Please read through the pattern.

1. Trace onto heavy cardboard or template plastic the triangle template from the pattern. Cut out .
