

## Rockport Tote Supply List

(Large or Medium Size)

Pattern: Rockport Tote

**Fabric      You will need to have ALL your fabric cutting done prior to class**

Sides and Bottom = 1 yard (Both Large & Small Totes)

Horizontal direction print add  $\frac{1}{4}$  yd for large tote (vertical direction – selvage to selvage no extra needed)

Binding & Handles =  $\frac{3}{4}$  yard or purchase Happy Handles kit

Optional closure – Use leftovers from either fabric

Dbl Sided Fusible Batting: Bosal's Duet Fuse II = 1 yard for both sizes

STIFF Dbl sided Fusible Interfacing such as Pellon 72F =  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard for both sizes

Cotton Batting for handles, about 5" by WOF or use leftovers or Happy Handles Kit

Screen spline for handles = 6' of .140" wide spline (available at hardware stores OR  $\frac{1}{4}$ " tubing available in plumbing section\*)

### Decorative Buttons

Totes without a closure: 2 large (1  $\frac{3}{4}$ ") & 2 medium (Optional)

Totes with a closure: 1 or 2 sew in magnetic snaps 4 med (1") or 2 lg (1  $\frac{3}{4}$ ") & optional buttons

Matching Cotton Thread – piecing thread to match main fabric and sides and binding fabric

Sewing machine

machine needles, size 80

Parchment paper or Teflon pressing sheet

Removable marker or chalk

Clover wonder clips or long pins

Seam ripper, rulers/measuring tape

Milner's size 7 needle (helpful) or other longer thin needle for hand sewing

**\*If you buy  $\frac{1}{4}$ " tubing for your handles you will need to cut your fabric 2  $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide rather than 1  $\frac{3}{4}$ "**
