- 2-Disappearing Hourglass with Various Lay outs by Dianne Nordyke. Your choice of project size. Class fee \$1.50 pattern
- 3-Sewing machine table runner by Judy Craig. Create a useful mat with pockets for your sewing area.
- 4-Fabric boxes by Jannet Pruit. Turn fabric squares into baskets for all occasions.
- 5-Dressed Up Pillow by Candy Robinson. Glam up your living space with a decorator pillow for any season. Kit fee \$12 Pattern only \$5
