What do you need to do to get involved?

- Complete the registration form for your quilt which is available below or download from the website, fill in and return to Michelle Litke. Registration is due between October 8-November 8. A picture and a short description of your piece is a required part of the registration. Registration forms can also be dropped off at the October guild meeting.
- Please be sure there is a hanging sleeve or hanging corners on your piece.
- For insurance purposes, once registration is completed, each person will need to sign an individual agreement from the city of Keizer.

For those that have participated in the past, quilt drop off and pick up is a little different. Quilts should be dropped off Monday November 30 between 4-6 pm at the Keizer Civic Center on Chemewa Road. They will be securely stored overnight and hung the next day. Quilts should be picked up on Friday, January 29 between 4-6 pm.
