

# Zig

Level of Experience: Beginner to Advanced

Finished Size: 53" x 74"

Zig is a fast paced quilt with a lot of possibilities. After mastering the basic construction – you will learn additional options for smaller, larger and modified blocks as well as different layout possibilities all starting with the same fabric squares. FYI, This is fabulous *Stash Quilt!*



## FABRIC TIP

Zig is stash-friendly, so if you *happen* to have a fabric stash, dive in cut a variety of rectangles as listed below or, follow the yardage requirements. Make it out of your favorite light and dark colors, add in or subtract out fabrics as you wish. For the dark parts of the blocks, I used a variety of medium blue, turquoise and green prints, referred to as blue in the fabric requirements. For the light parts of the blocks, I used a mix of tone on tone and light value prints, referred to as light in the fabric requirements. Enjoy!

## SUPPLIES

Pattern: Zig By Karla Alexander

Sewing machine in good working order

Basic rotary cutting and sewing supplies

Suggested: 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" acrylic square ruler

OPTIONAL: 2 yards flannel for design wall

OPTIONAL: Specialty ruler: Straight out of Line (pattern includes template)

## Fabric Listed by Required Yardage

1/4 yard of **5 different** blue prints

1/4 yard of **5 different** light prints

1/2 yard of **3 different** light prints

Binding .....5/8 yard

Backing .....3 5/8 yards

## Block Fabric Listed by Required Rectangles

25 Dark Rectangles, 8" x 8 1/2"

39 Light Rectangles, 8" x 8 1/2"

14 Light Setting Triangles, (see inside pattern for exact size)

## PLEASE PRE-CUT AS FOLLOWS PRIOR TO CLASS

From the light prints, cut a variety of 39 rectangles, 8" x 8 1/2"

From the dark prints, cut a variety of 25 rectangles, 8" x 8 1/2"

The remaining fabric will be cut in class.
