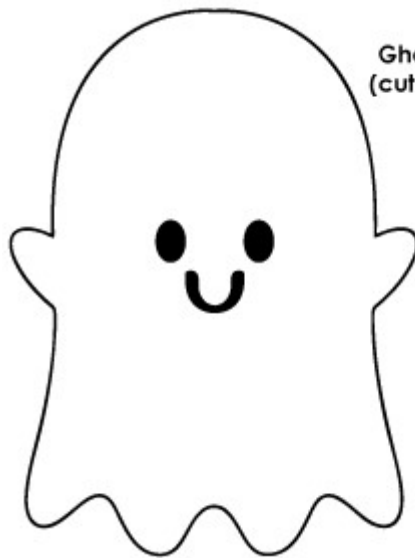


Ghouls Just Want to Have Fun Bag Charm

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MATERIALS

- Front and Back Fabric: (2) 3" x 4" scraps of fabric or 2 charm squares
- Soft & Stable: (1) 3" x 4" piece of Soft & Stable (available in black or white – choose the colourway that coordinates with chosen fabric)



Ghost Template
(cut on solid line)

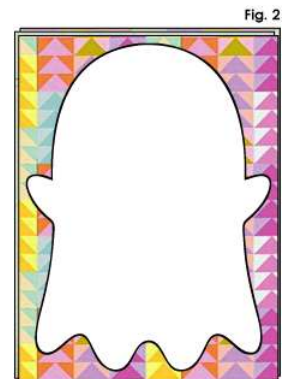
OTHER MATERIALS

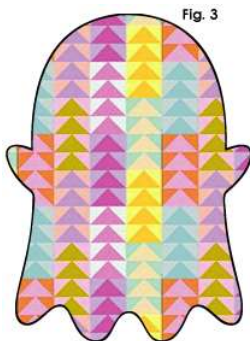
- 12" piece of 1/4" wide ribbon
- 1 keyring, D-ring, or swivel hook
- Template plastic or card stock
- Frixion Fineline pen (choose a colour that contrasts chosen fabric).
- Micron pen in Black
- Odif 505 Glue Stick
- Konfetti 50 wt cotton thread
- Pfaff Open Toe Appliqué or Sewing Stars foot
- Fray-Check sealant
- Craft glue or hot glue

CONSTRUCTION

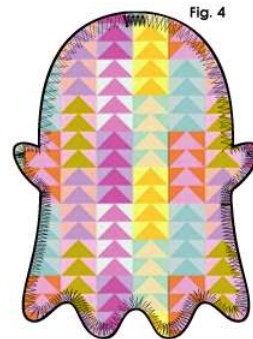
1. Print out the ghost template. Trace or glue it to the template plastic or card stock and cut on the solid line. Set aside.

2. Glue a 3" x 4" piece of fabric to either side of the Soft & Stable using the Odif 505 Glue Stick (with wrong sides of the fabric touching the Soft & Stable, Fig. 1); press with an iron to smooth out any wrinkles (Fig. 2). Use the Frixion Fineline pen to trace the ghost template onto one of the fabric sides (Note: Frixion pens disappear with heat – if your fabric is still warm from the iron let it cool before marking on it with the pen). Cut out along the drawn line (Fig. 3).





3. Using a Pfaff Open Toe Appliqué or Sewing Stars foot and zig-zag stitch, sew along the outside perimeter of the ghost. (Note: we set our zig-zag stitch to 3.6 mm wide and 2.0 mm long. Shorten the length for a satin-stitch if preferred) (Fig. 4).



4. Cut a piece of ribbon 3-1/2" long and fold in half and finger press. Apply Fray-Check to the cut ends to prevent fraying. Let it dry, then run the ribbon through the keyring, D-ring, or swivel hook and place on the top front centre of the ghost and cross the ribbon ends. Stitch in place using a 2.0 mm straight stitch (Fig. 5). Next, take the remaining ribbon and tie into a bow, then trim the ends to desired length. Apply Fray check to the cuts ends and dry. Use craft glue or hot glue to place the bow directly on top of the folded ribbon stitching. Refer to the template for eye and mouth placement and draw a face on the ghost with the Frixion Fineliner pen.

5. Once satisfied with the placement colour it in with the Micron pen and press to set the ink (Fig. 6).
