

PROGRESS PRIDE QUILT



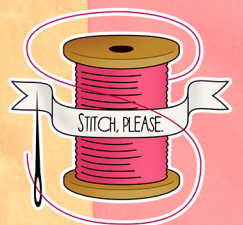

Fabric Requirements:

- 0.15m each of red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple & pink
- 0.2m each light blue, brown & black
- 0.25m white (long or fat)
- 0.35m binding
- 1.5m backing (1m if using wide backing)



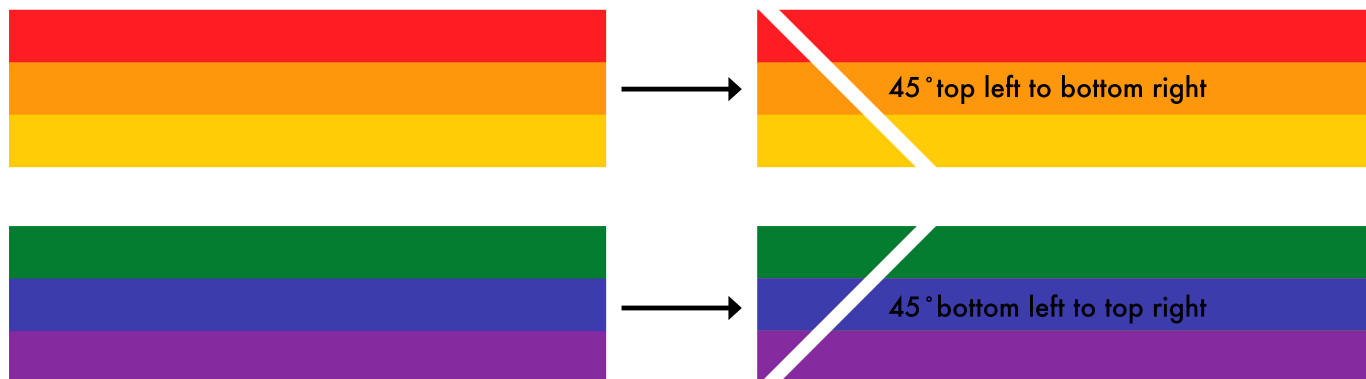

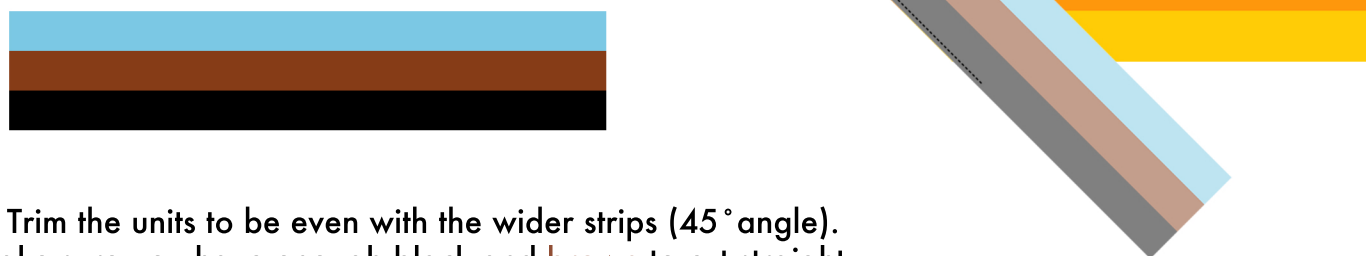
Cutting:

- (1) 5.5" x WOF strip EACH of red, orange, yellow, green, blue & purple
- (2) 3.5" x WOF strips EACH of light blue, brown, & black
- (1) 3.5" x WOF strip of pink, subcut this in half to approximately 3.5"x20"
- (1) 10" square of white

1. Sew strip sets together of (red, orange, yellow) and (green, blue, purple). Using a 45° angle, trim off one end. Make sure the red and purple remain the longest strips and have the angle cut in the correct direction.



2. Sew (2) strip sets of (light blue, brown, black). Starting about 6" from the end of the set, sew the black edge to the angled edge of your previous strip sets.



3. Trim the units to be even with the wider strips (45° angle). Make sure you have enough black and brown to cut straight across. If the light blue has a clipped corner, that is alright.

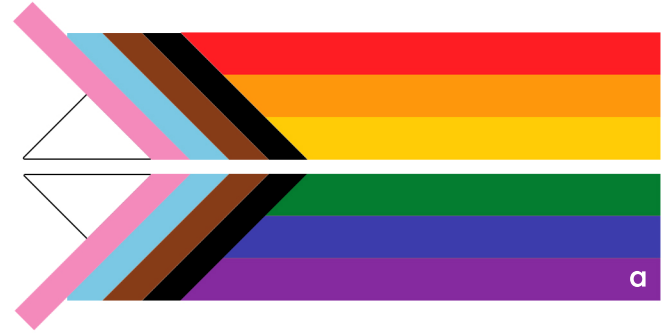


4. Sew your pink strips onto the light blue strips. Trim these to be even with the yellow and green edges.



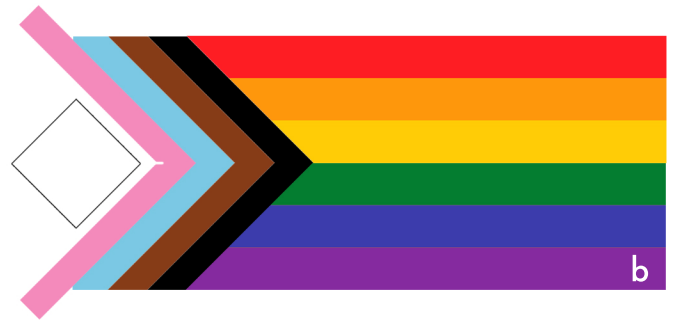
7. At this point, you will need to insert your white square. You have two methods to choose from:

a) cut your 10" square in half on the diagonal and sew one half to each of the pink strips, concentrating on lining up with what will become the centre seam. Sew the centre seam.

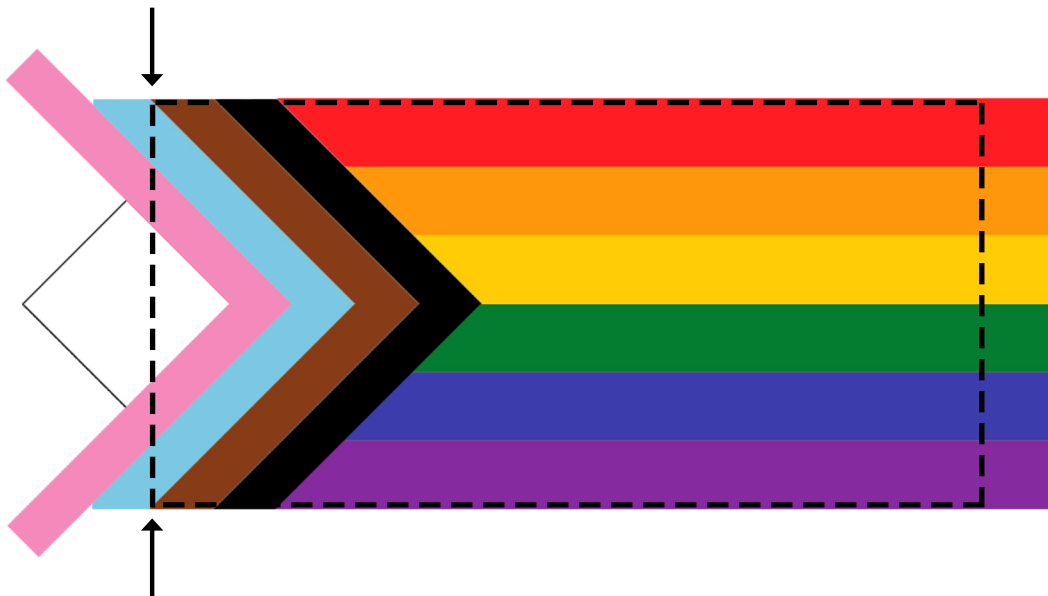


OR

b) Sew your centre seam first, stopping about 1/2" from the angled end. Insert your 10" square with a Y-Seam.



8. Trim your quilt to roughly 30"x50" (final size will depend on the original width of fabric). Concentrate on the corners landing where the light blue and brown strips meet.



9. Quilt and bind as desired.
