

FIRESIDE SANTA HAT

Supplies Needed

- * 2 pieces of red Fireside measuring 16" x half the circumference of your head + 1"
E.g. if your head measures 22" around, you will need (2) 16"x12" pieces of Fireside
- * 1 piece of white fireside measuring 6"x approximately 30"

Instructions (read through before you begin):

1. Mark the middle of your red fireside lengthwise (folding in half and creasing it does the trick).
2. Stack your 2 red Fireside rectangles. Cut from the middle mark to each corner to make 2 identical triangles. (Figure 1)
3. Lay out your strip of white, fuzzy side up. Lay your triangles on top, matching raw edges at the top of the white strip. It does not matter if your triangles are fuzzy side up or down. (Figure 2)

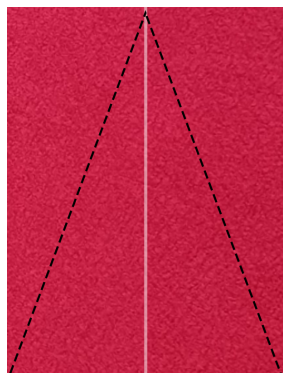

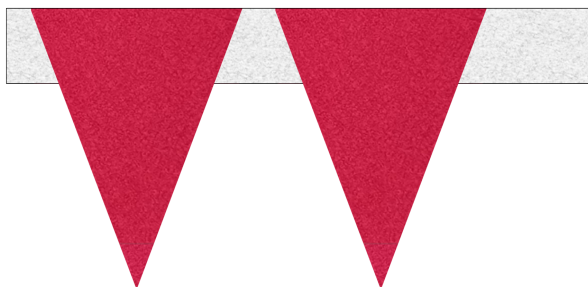

4. Roll up the triangles so they fit within the white strip (Figure 3). Fold the white strip over to match raw edges and sew a 1/2" seam all the way along until you have sewn over both red triangles. You will now have a tube (Figure 4).

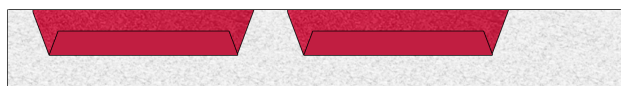

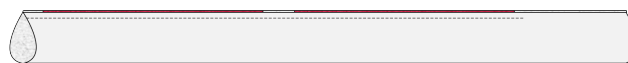

5. Turn your tube inside out. Cut the cuff even with the edges of the triangles. You should have a piece of white left over. Reserve this for making the pop-pom. Place your two pieces right sides together and sew a 1/2" seam along the raw edges. Backstitch at the beginning and the end. Turn right sides out.

6. Cut a large circle out of the remaining white Fireside and hand sew a gathering stitch around the outside edge (Figure 5). Gather up the pom pom and stuff with leftover Fireside scraps or polyfil. Tie off and handsew the pom pom to the tip of the hat.

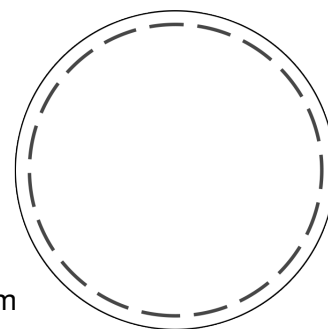
